RESOLUTION 24-17**

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION BY THE TOWN OF FRISCO TO THE STATE OF COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS FOR THE ENERGY/MINERAL IMPACT ASSISTANCE FUND GRANT

WHEREAS, the Frisco Town Council has identified the 100% completion of the Granite Street Complete Streets Design as high priority goal in the Town Council Strategic Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town recognizes that Granite Street is a critical street in the core of Frisco which requires improvements to improve pedestrian safety, add core infrastructure, provide pedestrian connections to workforce housing, and add parking to assist with future development of workforce housing ; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Local Affairs (DOLA) administers the Energy/Mineral Impact Assistance Fund Grant to assist political subdivisions that are socially and/or economically impacted by the development, processing, or energy conversion of minerals and mineral fuels; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Frisco is requesting a grant from DOLA to assist in completing the final design for the Granite Street phase of the Downtown Complete Streets Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FRISCO, COLORADO THAT:

SECTION 1: The Town Council of the Town of Frisco strongly supports the application and has appropriated funds for matching a grant with DOLA.

SECTION 2: The Town Council of the Town of Frisco authorizes the expenditure of funds as necessary to meet the terms and obligations of any grant awarded.

SECTION 3: This resolution to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
