RESOLUTION 24-36**

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE STATE HIGHWAY 9 CORRIDOR WITHIN THE TOWN OF FRISCO FOR USE BY THE TOWN FOR AUTOMATED VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, Colorado Senate Bill 24-195, effective June 8, 2024 (the “Act”), amended Colorado statutes concerning the use by the state and municipalities, and their related law enforcement agencies, of automated vehicle identification systems (AVIS) to detect and issue notices of traffic violations; and

WHEREAS, with respect to the use of AVIS on state highways, the Act provides certain rule-making authority to the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) concerning the use of AVIS by more than one governmental entity on a single portion of state highway; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 42-4-110.5(c), C.R.S., the rules to be promulgated by CDOT will not apply to the use of AVIS on a state highway within a municipality where the municipality has designated, by resolution before January 1, 2025, a portion of the highway for use by the Town’s AVIS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FRISCO, COLORADO THAT:

All parts of Colorado State Highway 9 that are contained within the boundaries of the Town of Frisco, Colorado, are hereby designated for use by the Town for an automated vehicle identification system or systems for enforcement of local and state traffic laws and regulations.
