**RE: RESOLUTION 24-36, A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE STATE HIGHWAY 9 CORRIDOR WITHIN THE TOWN OF FRISCO FOR USE BY THE TOWN FOR AUTOMATED VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION SYSTEMS.**

**Summary and Background:** This Resolution is proposed in response to Colorado Senate Bill 24-195 (the “Act”), concerning the use of automated vehicle detections systems (“AVIS”) to enforce traffic laws. AVIS are the systems used to detect speeding or traffic light violations and, potentially, to send automatic notices of traffic infractions to violators. The Act gives the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”) the authority to adopt rules concerning the use of AVIS on state highways when more than one governmental entity desires to use the system on a single portion of state highway. However, the Act also provides that CDOT’s rules will not apply where a municipality has designated, before January 1, 2025, a portion of state highway within its boundaries for the use of AVIS.

**Analysis:** The adoption of this Resolution would preserve the Town’s ability to use AVIS on Highway 9 without the need to comply with CDOT’s rules concerning the use of such systems on a state highway by more than one governmental entity. The actual implementation of AVIS within any part of the Town would require additional action by the Town Council in the form, at a minimum, of a budget appropriation to pay for AVIS equipment, and potentially in the form of a contract with a third party for the administration of an AVIS.

**Financial Impact:** Approval of this Resolution will have no financial impact to the Town’s budget.

**Alignment with Strategic Plan:** This Resolution aligns with Town Council’s Quality Core Services goals.

**Environmental Sustainability:** This Resolution has no impact on environmental sustainability.

**Staff Recommendation:** Staff recommends that the Town Council consider approving the attached Resolution.
