A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE 10 YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE
TOWN OF FRISCO

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Frisco recognizes the importance of long-term planning to ensure the efficient use of public funds and the successful completion of capital projects that benefit the community.

WHEREAS, the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) is a multi-year planning document that outlines the Town's capital needs, identifies available funding sources, and establishes priorities for infrastructure projects.

WHEREAS, the Town Council has reviewed and discussed the proposed CIP, including the prioritization of projects based on their importance, feasibility, and available funding.

WHEREAS, the Town Council believes that the adoption of the CIP will provide a roadmap for the successful completion of critical infrastructure projects, improving the quality of life for residents and contributing to the Town's continued growth and development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FRISCO, COLORADO THAT:

Section 1. The Town Council hereby adopts the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) for the Town of Frisco.

Section 2. The Town Council directs Town staff to proceed with the implementation of the CIP and to update the program annually to reflect new needs, funding sources, and project priorities.

Section 3. That said capital program as submitted is hereby approved and adopted for the Town of Frisco for 2025-2034.
