RE: SECOND READING ORDINANCE 24-19: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 171 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF FRISCO, COLORADO, CONCERNING WATER, BY AMENDING ARTICLE V THEREOF, CONCERNING WATER CONSERVATION, TO STANDARDIZE RESTRICTIONS CONCERNING THE WATER OR IRRIGATION OF LAWS AND OTHER AREAS OF LAND

Summary & Background:

Ordinance 24-19 had the first reading take place on November 12, 2024 for the Frisco Town Council. There have been no changes made to this ordinance in preparation for the second reading set to take place December 10, 2024. As a brief summary, Ordinance 24-19 is put forth to fix an administrative error that occurred in the final copy of Ordinance 24-07. The administrative error occurred when a typo mislabeled the Unified Watering Schedule using the term “Odd” when referencing property address’s and should be changed to “Even”. Additionally, the same typo occurred in the final draft using the term “Even” that needs to be changed using the term “Odd”. This change is proposed to align with County wide watering restrictions.

Analysis:

This correction is necessary to align with the County wide irrigation restriction schedule.

Financial Impact:

None at this time.

Environmental Sustainability:

This correction would promote environmental sustainability by improving water conservation guidance, administration, and compliance.

Alignment with Strategic Plan:

The 2024-2028 Frisco Strategic Plan includes the strategic objective, “Provide progress-driven Quality Core Services.” Within this objective, one key pillar is environmental stewardship and climate change, which emphasizes the commitment to protecting the environment and taking proactive steps to mitigate the effects of climate change.

The proposed correction would improve stewardship of the Town’s water resources and is consistent with the Strategic Plan and the Town Council’s goals for promoting sustainability.
