A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION BY THE TOWN OF FRISCO TO THE STATE OF COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS FOR THE STRONG COMMUNITIES GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, political subdivisions of Summit County, Colorado completed a housing needs assessment in 2023 identifying housing needs at a wide range of Area Median Income (AMI) percentages throughout Summit County, including the Town of Frisco; and

WHEREAS, the Frisco Town Council has identified workforce housing goals as a high priority goal in the Town Council Strategic Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town recognizes that the demand for workforce housing in Town is currently exceeding the available supply required for a robust and active economy in the Frisco commercial core; and

WHEREAS, the Strong Communities Grant Program provides funding to local governments for infrastructure associated with the development of community benefit-driven infill affordable housing that meets critical housing needs as identified by the local government; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Frisco is requesting a grant from the State of Colorado to assist in the construction of infrastructure related to two workforce housing projects, located at 101 W Main Street and 602 Galena Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FRISCO, COLORADO THAT:

SECTION 1: The Town Council of the Town of Frisco strongly supports the application and has appropriated funds for matching a grant.

SECTION 2: The Town Council of the Town of Frisco authorizes the expenditure of funds as necessary to meet the terms and obligations of any grant awarded.

SECTION 3: Partnerships for this project will be secured upon award of grant funding.

SECTION 4: This resolution to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
