I am asking the city of Frisco town counsel for permission to allow a water tap to my property on Lot 153 of Bills ranch. I do have a sewer line to the property that was installed in 1990's along with three other properties on the Goldfinch Lane road. A right of way has been in place since 1982 when the property was purchased.

The water tap and line will allow me to use my cabin in greater comfort. My family and I have enjoyed Frisco for many years – from the pancake breakfasts on the 4th of July and the parade since the time it was a '2-block' event to an annual Hockey Fest after Thanksgiving on the ranch ponds. City water would allow incorporation of a bathroom and shower in our cabin and greater use of our property for extended vacations.
