Accountant Dylan Olchin stated that this ordinance amends the Town purchasing code. The revisions will enable the Town of Frisco to enter purchasing cooperatives in order to access lower pricing options than the Town could access on its own. This change does not negate the Town's ability to manage its own purchasing processes; rather it adds options to enter into purchasing agreements that are advantageous to the Town. The code amendments in this ordinance will also raise the purchasing limits for each level of accountability required: department manager's discretion, required verbal quote, required written quote, and required competitive bids. The current limits have been in place since adoption in July 2007, and the new limits were determined using the Bureau of Labor Statistics CPI Inflation Calculator. Mayor Mortensen opened public comment at 7:02 p.m. There being no public comment, the Mayor closed public comment at 7:04 p.m.
