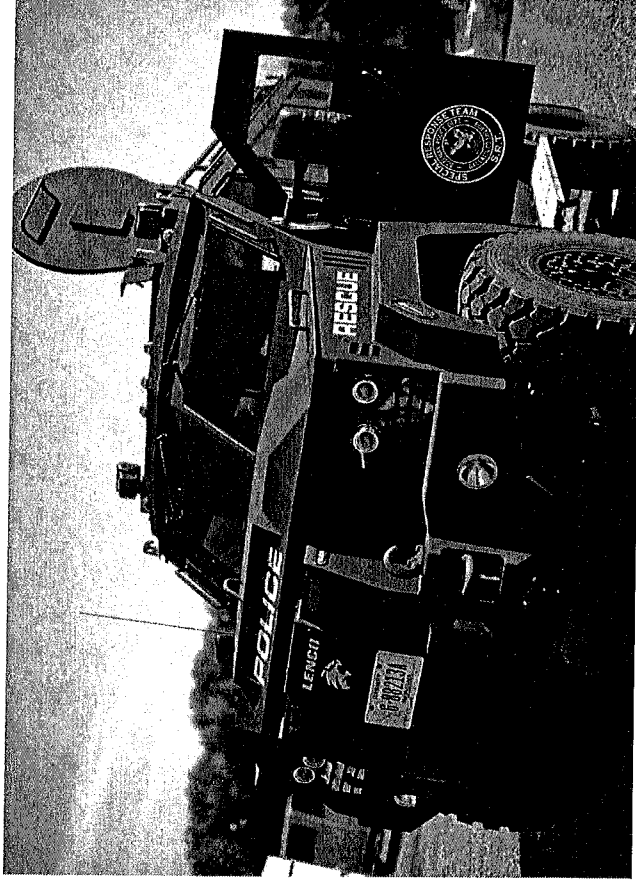

June 16, 2015

- An armed man barricaded himself in a hotel room with a small child.
- SRT was called in to negotiate after the man fired a shot at responding officers.
- A BearCat was brought in to contain the entryway and protect officers.
- Upon seeing the vehicle, the suspect surrendered.

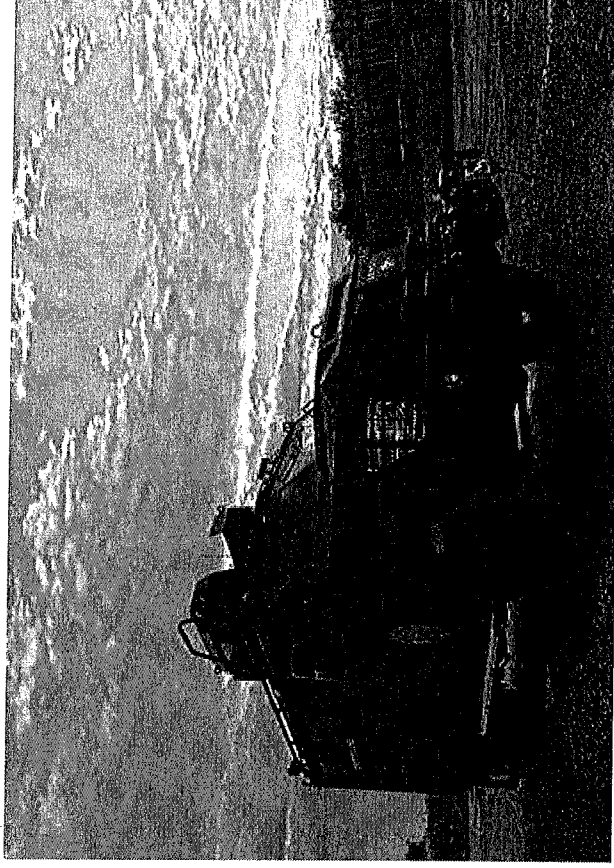

Kansas Highway Patrol SRT

June 24, 2015

- Armed suspect attempts home invasion.
- When police arrive on scene, the suspect flees leading to a pursuit.
- The suspect eventually pulls into an open field and begins firing at state police aircraft.
- The Highway Patrol SRT BearCat is used to approach the suspect to begin negotiations.
- After speaking with negotiators in the BearCat, the suspect surrenders without incident.

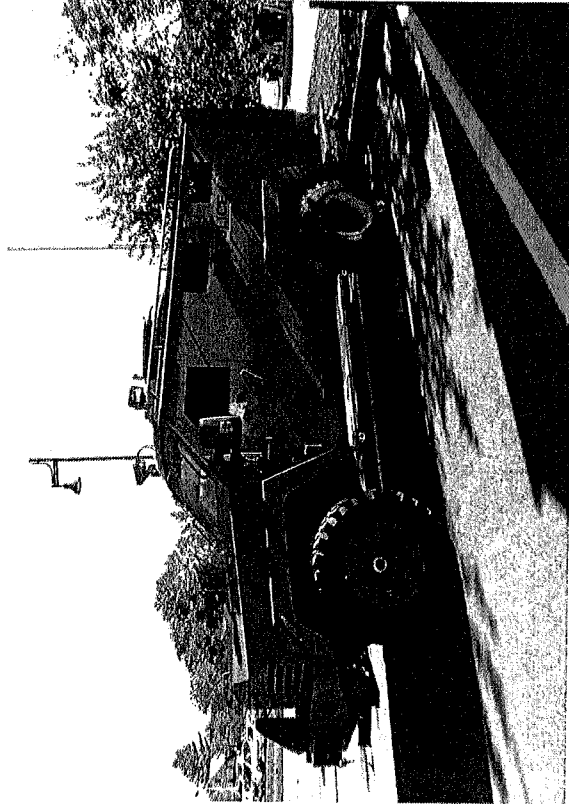

- Armed biker gangs were planning a confrontation during a local concert.
- Multiple departments respond to help prevent violence.
- A BearCat is used to prevent people from entering the event.
- The threat quickly faded due to the police presence.

"We knew that they were armed and thought our best bet would be a show of force. And it worked. I'm proud of what we did. No one was hurt and no one was arrested." Bannock County Sheriff Lorin Nielsen

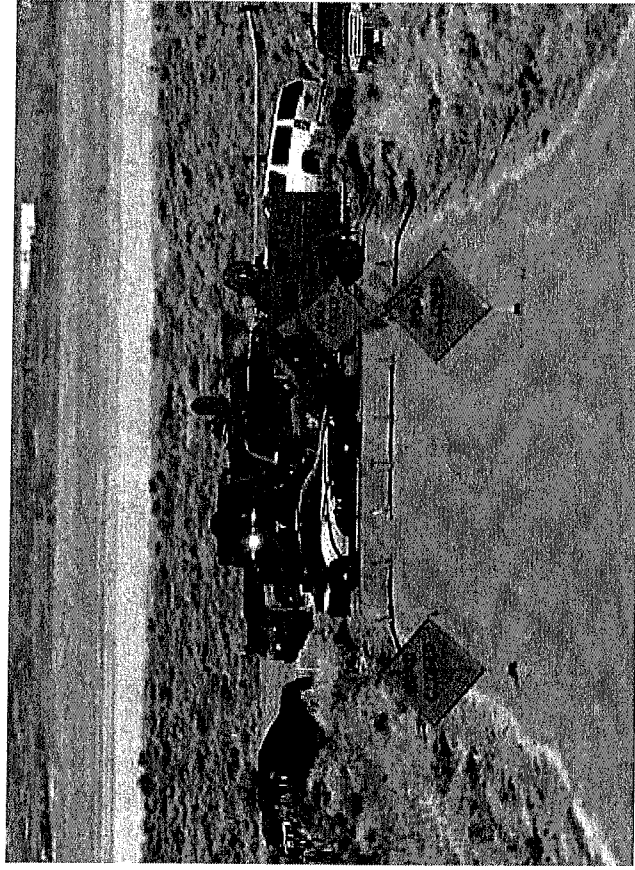

- Police called to respond to an armed barricaded suspect who had threatened his neighbor.
- Upon the arrival of police, the suspect refused to leave his house, leading to an 8 hour standoff.
- Keene PD SWAT was called and used their BearCat to help secure the perimeter and protect officers.
- After speaking with negotiators, the suspect finally surrendered and was taken into custody.

The BearCat was used to help contain a potentially volatile situation, giving negotiators time to ensure a peaceful resolution to the incident.

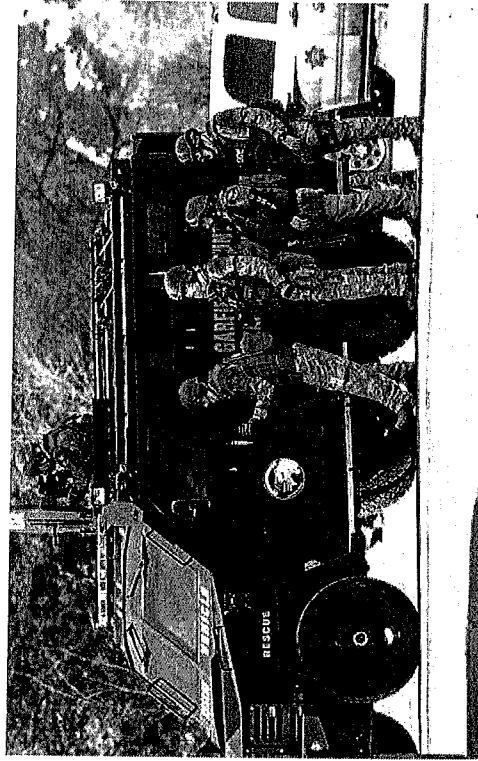
January-February 2016

- Heavily armed anti government militia takes over a wildlife refuge for 5 weeks.
- After occupation leaders are arrested, the remaining militia members block the road to keep law enforcement out.
- BearCats are used at roadblocks to prevent more militia supporters from entering the refuge.
- After more than 2 weeks of negotiations, all remaining occupiers surrender with the final negotiations conducted from inside of a BearCat.

The presence of Lenco BearCats at the scene helped protect local, state and federal law enforcement officials as well as armed occupiers during a tense and potentially dangerous incident.

- Responding officers find the man barricaded in a home and holding his daughter hostage.
- SWAT is called in and uses a BearCat to gain access to the backyard to surround the house.
- After a 6 hour standoff, the man left the house and surrendered.

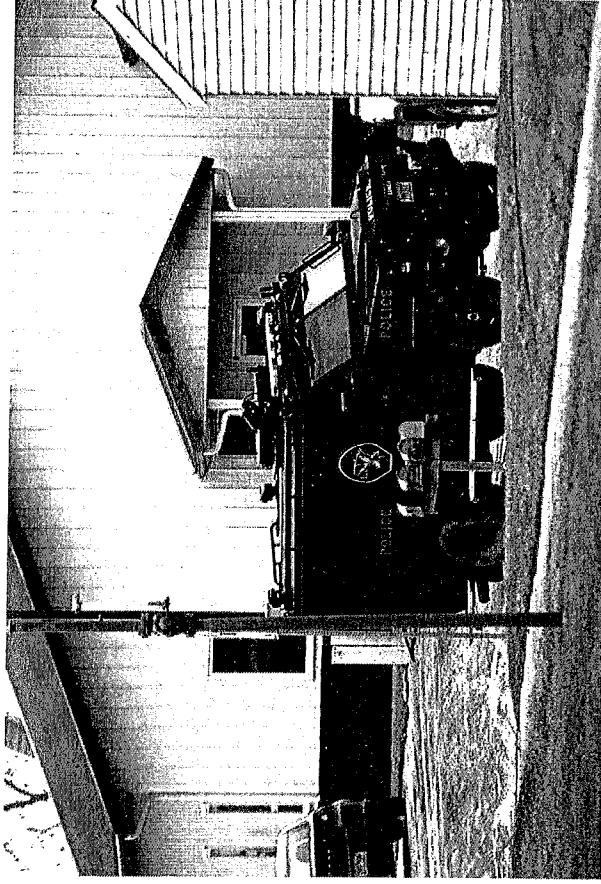

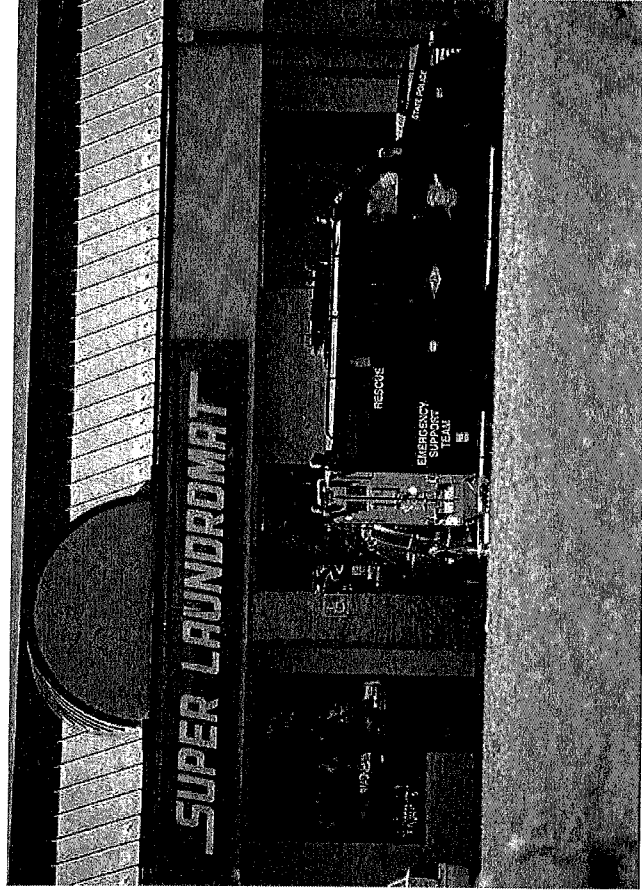
March 18, 2016

- Police receive a call regarding a man in a hotel room with a handgun.
- Responding patrol officers are fired at by the suspect.
- SWAT is called in and begins evacuating the hotel.
- A BearCat is used to allow negotiators to communicate safely with the suspect.
- After a 4 hour standoff, the suspect surrendered without incident.

The BearCat enabled negotiators to remain in close proximity to the scene to safely convince the suspect to surrender.

- Police responded to a report of an armed suspect involved in an altercation.
- Upon patrol's arrival, the suspect fled and barricaded himself in a local laundromat.
- The state police brought in a BearCat to help secure the front of the building.
- After a 9 hour standoff, the suspect lost consciousness and was taken into custody.

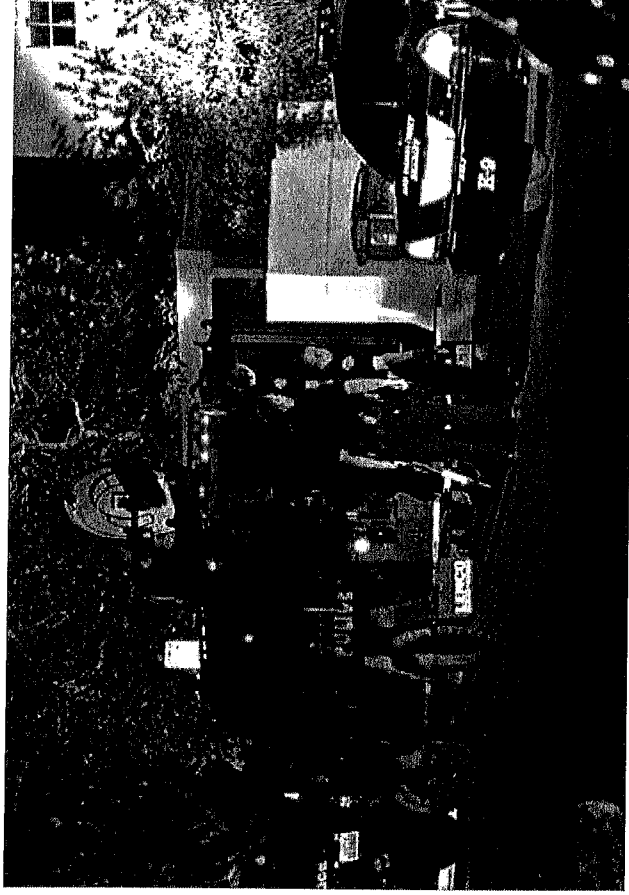

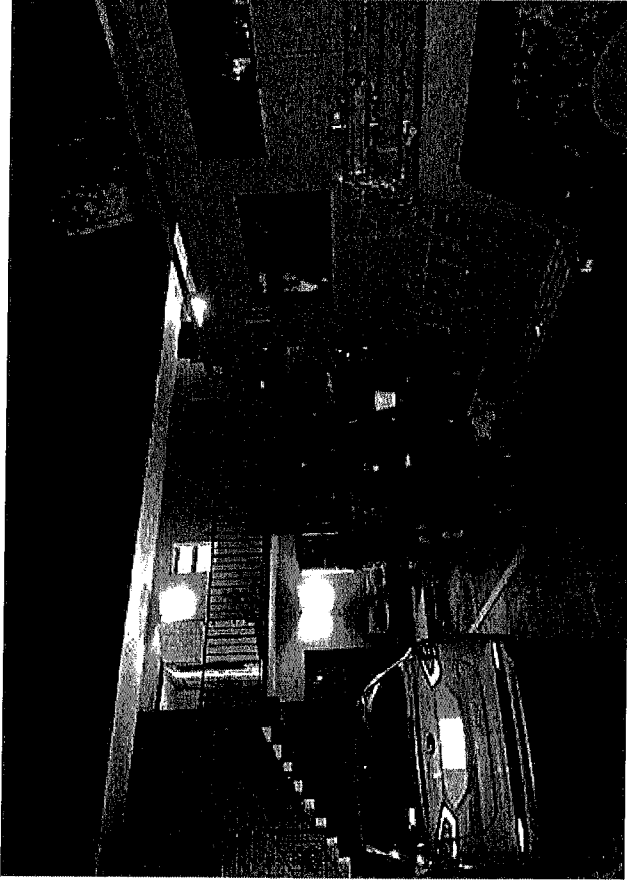

- SWAT deployed tear gas, forcing the suspect to surrender.

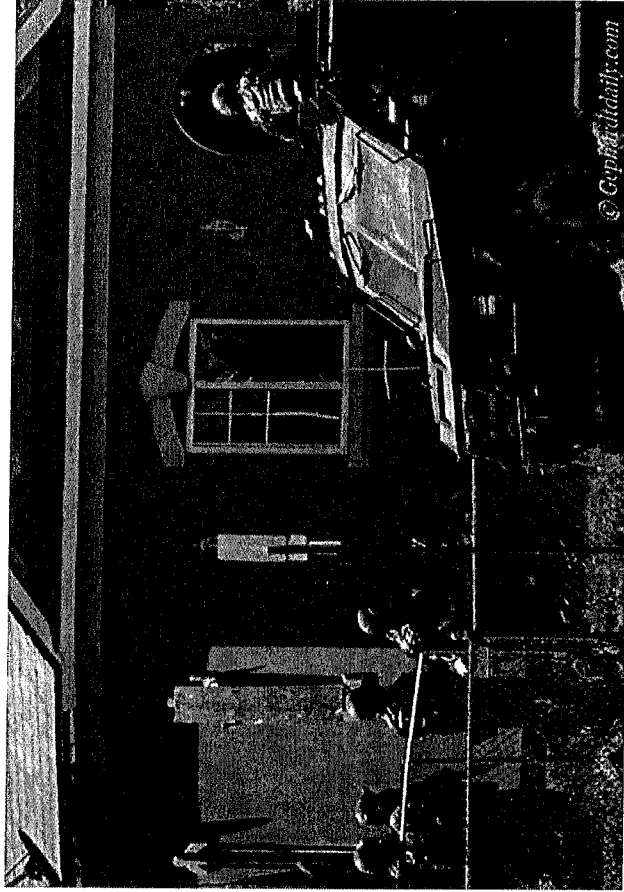

- When police arrive on scene, the suspect refuses to come out, points a laser at officers and begins making threats.
- SWAT is called in and use a BearCat for cover.
- After a 3 hour standoff, gas is deployed into the home.
- The suspect finally surrenders after speaking with a negotiator.

With the suspect clearly in a poor state of mind, the BearCat was used to keep SWAT operators safe while on scene and allow for law enforcement to find a peaceful resolution to the incident.

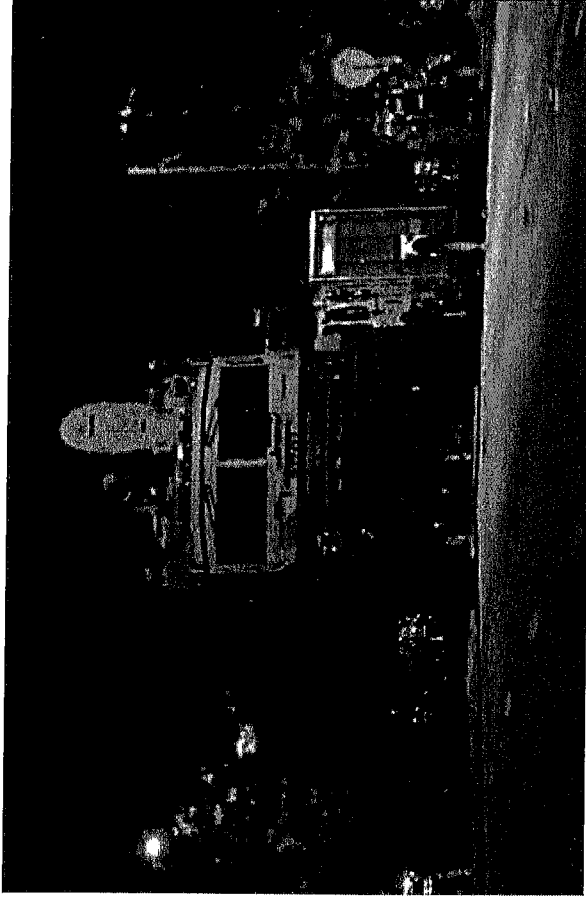

- SWAT is called in due to a domestic situation where a man struck his girlfriend in the head with a handgun.
- SWAT surrounded the house and used a BearCat to cover the front entrance.
- The victim and all other occupants of the house were able to exit safely.
- After a 2 hour standoff, flash bangs were deployed and SWAT entered the house.
- The suspect is found hiding in the basement and is taken into custody without incident.

"The Lenco BearCat provided immediate armored protection for our initial responding officers. Once the SWAT team arrived, and took command of the scene, the armored protection remained and allowed us to resolve this incident quickly."

- 8 total suspects are taken into custody.

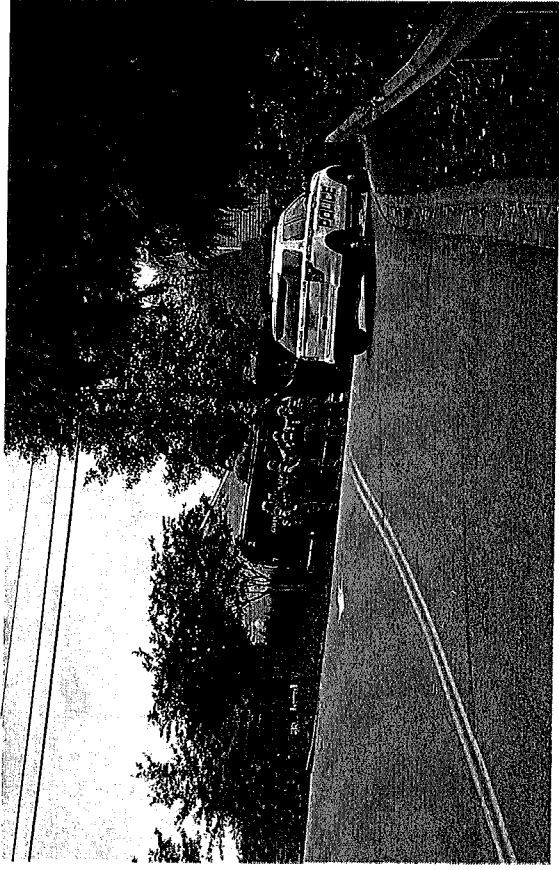

- When police made contact with the man, he became uncooperative and barricaded himself in an attic.
- SWAT was called in to handle the standoff.
- The team used a BearCat to secure a perimeter and began evacuating people from the area.
- The suspect surrendered after a 2 hour standoff.

Once the suspect barricaded himself in the apartment the BearCat was used to evacuate other residents in the complex, ensuring the safety of everyone in the area.

- A male suspect threatens store clerks with a knife after attempting to shop lift from a grocery store.
- Police corner the suspect after he flees the store.
- The suspect refuses to drop the knife and continues making threats, prompting a SWAT call out.
- SWAT attempts to negotiate, but after 3 hours call in 2 BearCats.
- The suspect surrenders as soon as the BearCat reaches the scene.

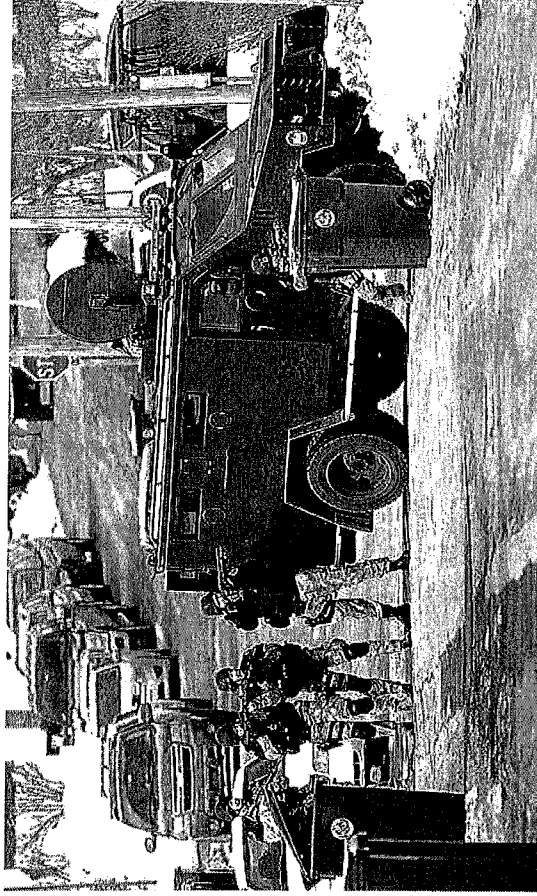

- A BearCat was used to safely communicate with the suspect and to protect a neighbor as she escaped her home.
- The suspect was taken into custody after SWAT entered the home.

- A BearCat was used to extract the officers.

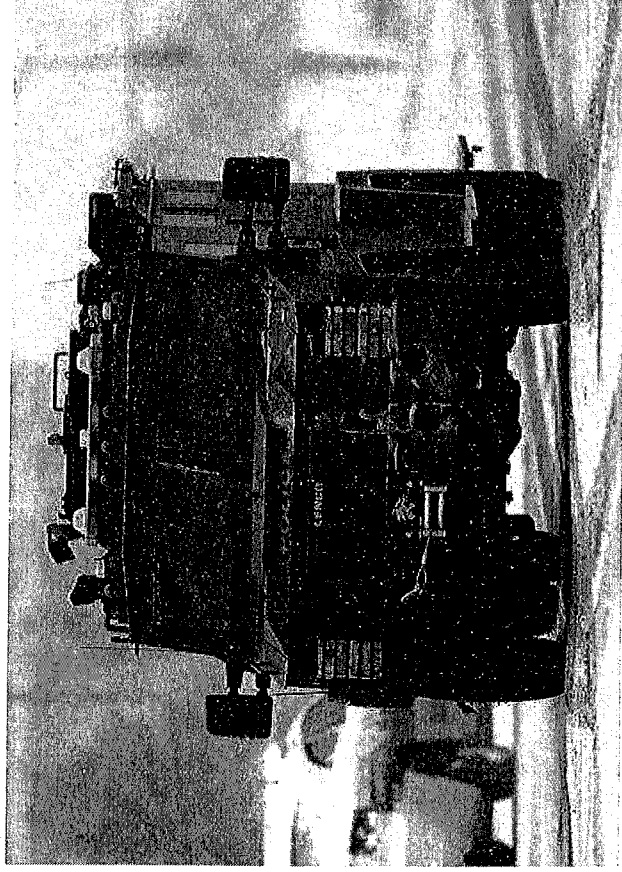

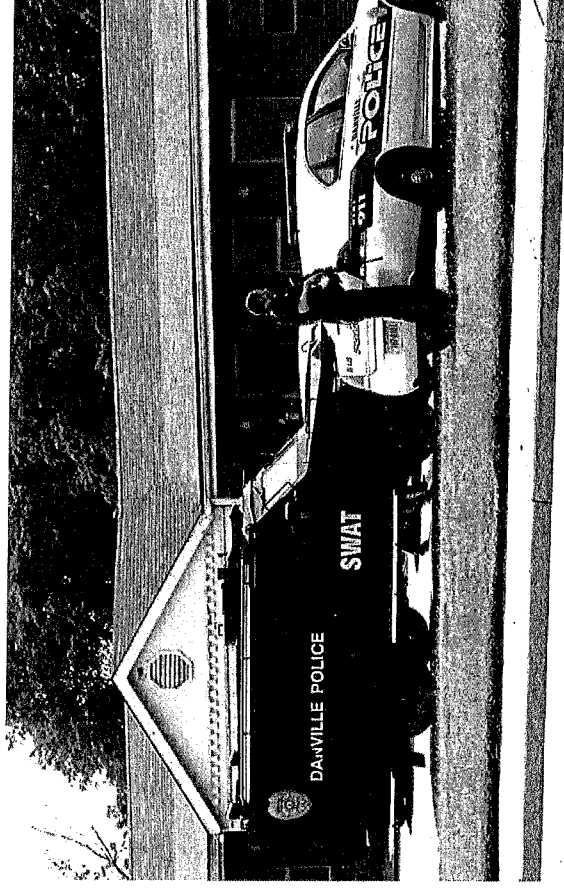

- A BearCat is repeatedly driven into the hot zone to extract civilians and carry them to safety.
- A B.E.A.R. is used to ram the front of the building to allow civilians to escape and force the suspect to surrender.

February 7, 2016

- Police responded to a call regarding a crime in a wooded area.
- Upon arrival they encountered an armed suspect attempting to commit suicide.
- After several hours of negotiations, the suspect began acting erratically and demanded to be killed.
- A BearCat was sent in to deploy less lethal options.
- The suspect was incapacitated and taken into custody without incident.

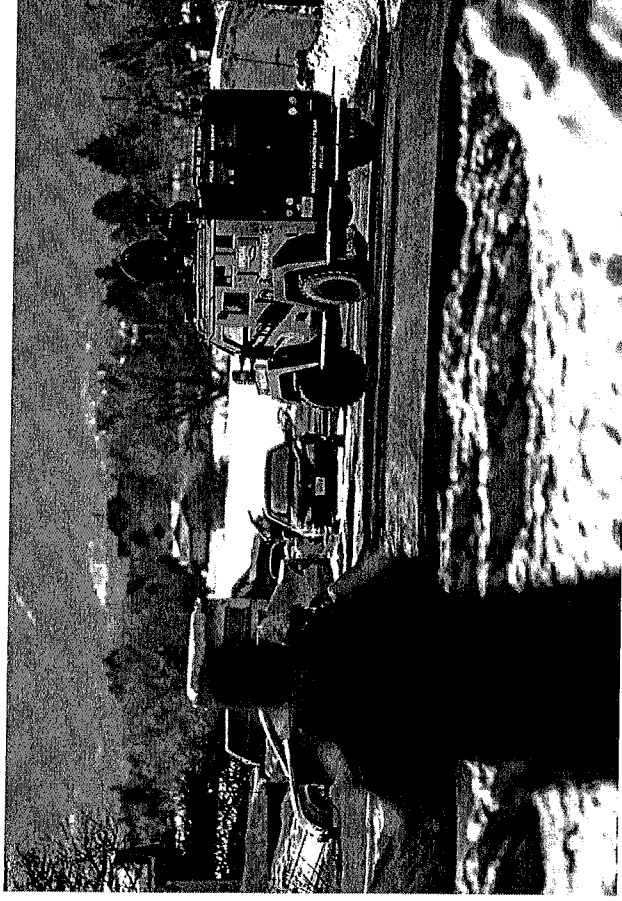

- Police responded to a report of a shot fired during an altercation in a house.
- The suspect refused to leave the building, starting a 12 hour standoff.
- A BearCat was brought in to provide protection to officers during negotiations.
- SRT officers were eventually able to approach the suspect in the back of the house and incapacitate him with a stun gun.

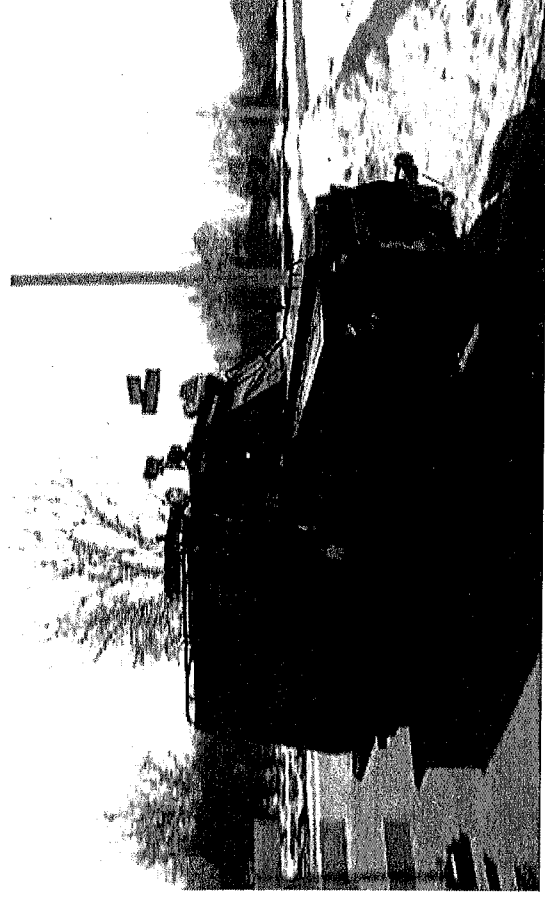

- SWAT was called in to serve a warrant on a suspected meth lab.
- 2 Suspects immediately surrendered.
- A third suspect hid in a garage.
- A BearCat was used to breach the garage.
- The suspect was taken into custody and the meth lab was seized.

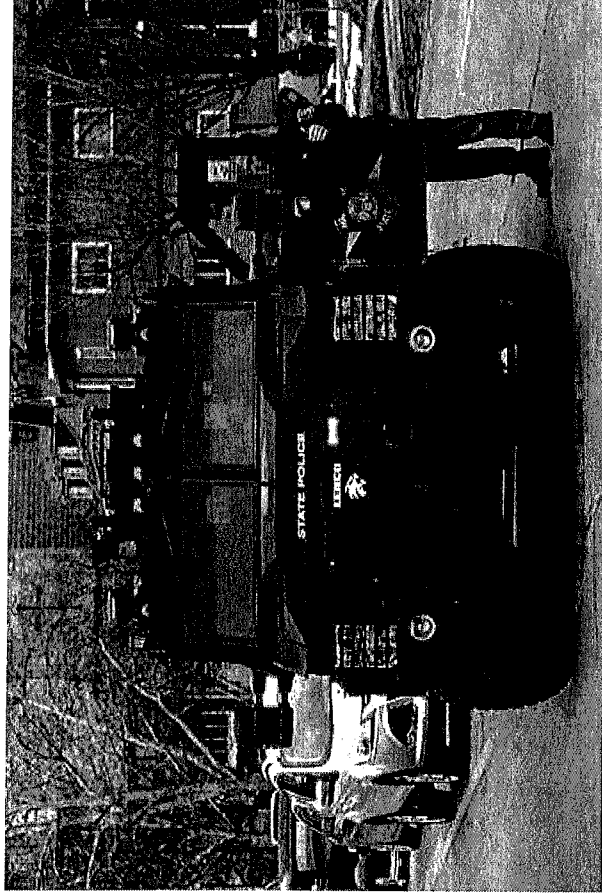

- 3 police officers were pinned down.
- A state police BearCat was used to extract the trapped officers.
- The standoff lasted for 22 hours.

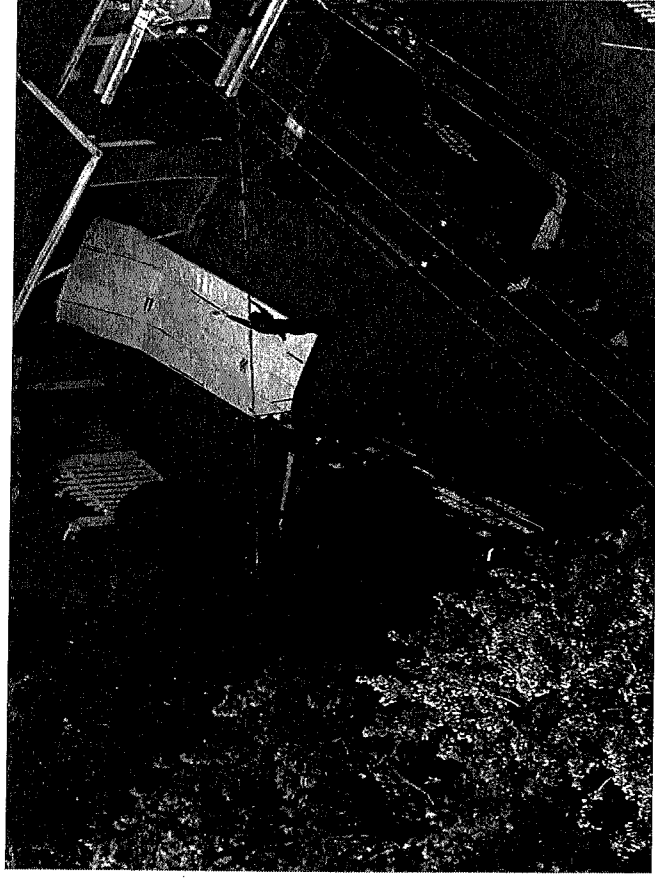

- The 2 wounded deputies are removed from the area and one dies at the hospital.
- Several SWAT teams are called in as the suspect barricades himself in a trailer for a number of hours.
- Indiana State Police BearCat is used to punch a hole in the trailer to locate the suspect.
- The suspect is confirmed dead.

"Without the assistance of the BearCat... information insuring the safety of officers on site would not have been confirmed." Kokomo PD SWAT

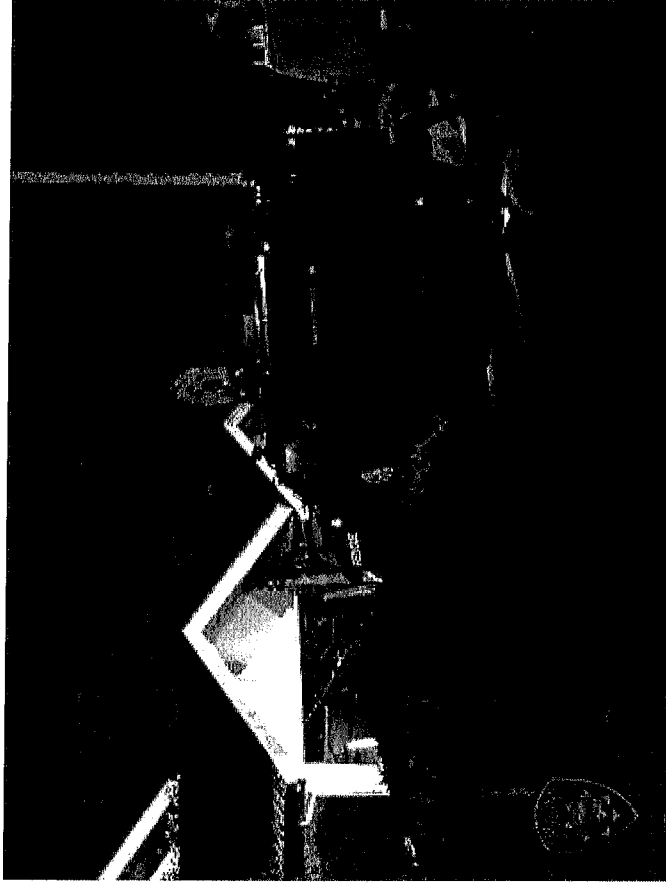

- SWAT was called in to deal with the barricaded suspect.
- After 5 hours a B.E.A.R. was used to tear the door off the garage.
- The suspect surrendered moments later.

"The suspect was in the garage firing at us. We used the B.E.A.R. to peel back the roll up garage door and expose his position." LAPD

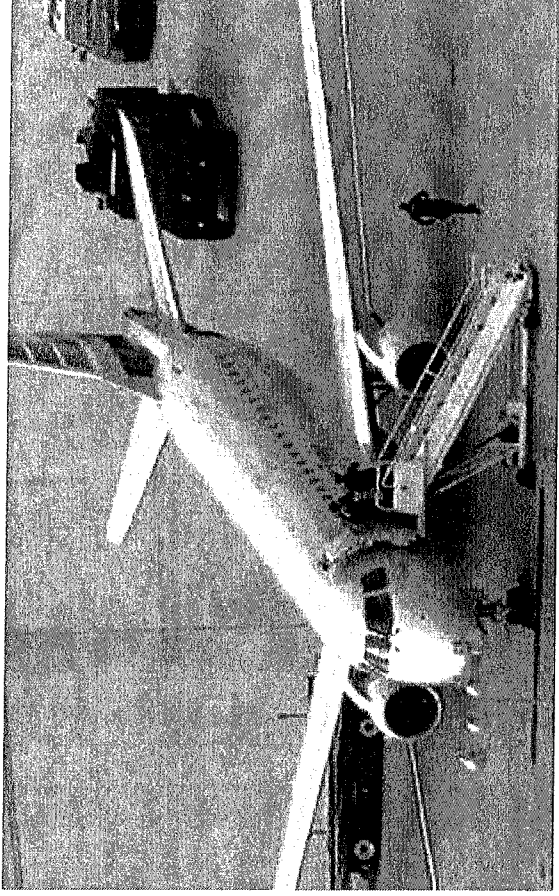

- Suspect begins firing weapon, forcing patrol and a civilian to take cover.
- A BearCat is used to extract the civilian.
- The BearCat is then positioned in front of the house to help secure the area.
- A 7 hour standoff ensues.

- Authorities received a bomb threat to a flight traveling from Houston, TX to LAX.
- The plane was moved to a remote area of the airport and SWAT was called in to search for an explosive.
- A BearCat was used to safely allow the team to safely approach the plane.
- After searching the plane and passengers the threat was deemed not credible.

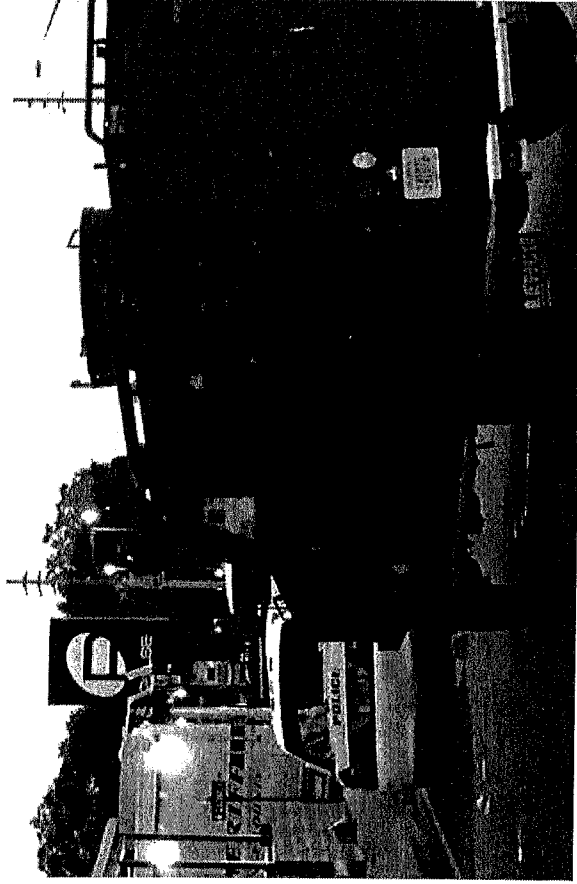

- A terrorist armed with an assault weapon opens fire in a night club, killing 49 and wounding 53.
- When police arrive on scene the suspect enters a restroom and takes several hostages.
- After a 3 hour standoff SWAT attempts to breach a wall in order to rescue those still inside the club.
- After attempting an explosive, a BearCat is used to ram the wall, allowing dozens of people to escape.

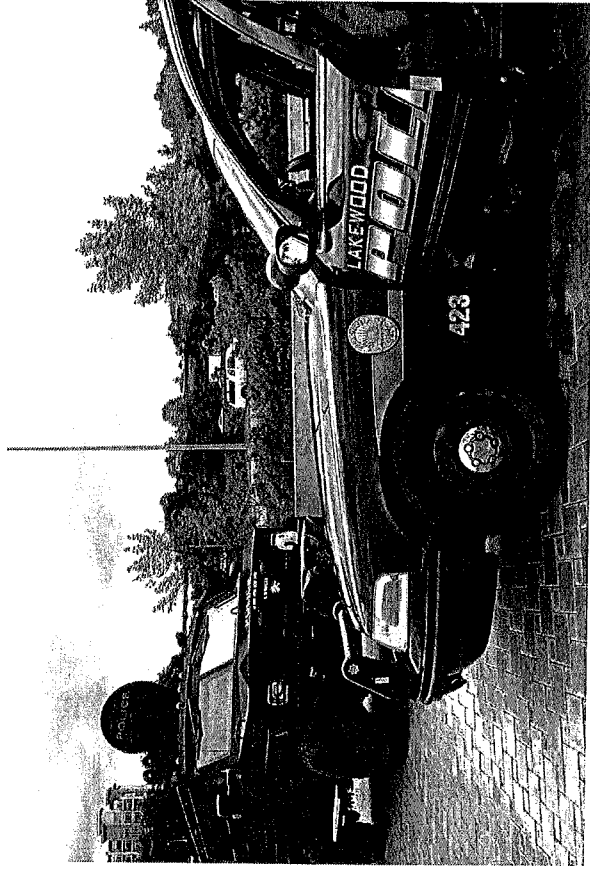

- Due to reports of firearms in the house, a BearCat was used to protect officers and assist in the search.
- The PA system on the BearCat was used to call out the occupants of the house.
- 6 individuals were arrested without incident.

- A SWAT team was called in to handle the standoff.
- After 6 hours, the suspect fired at SWAT team members taking cover in a BearCat.
- SWAT returned fire, wounding the suspect and taking him into custody.

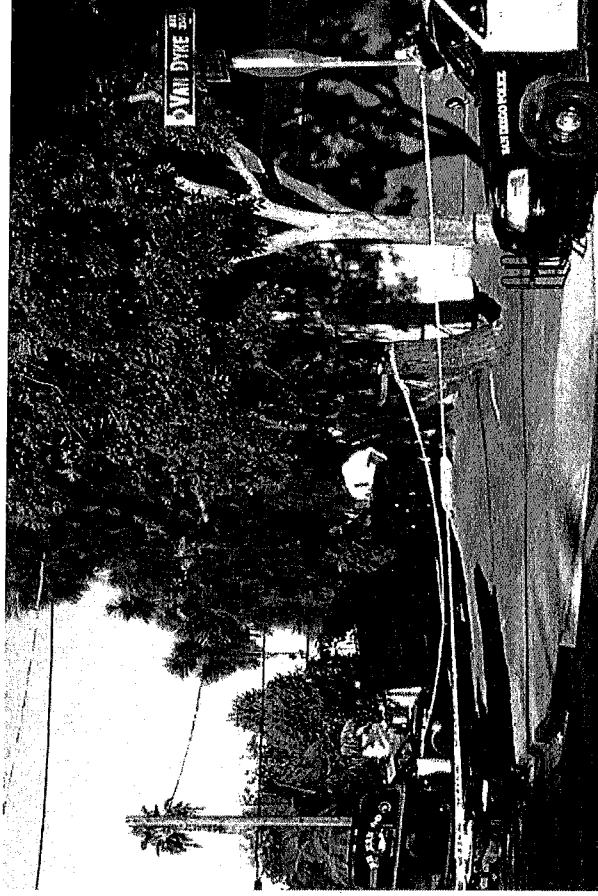

The BearCat was brought to the scene after the suspect fired at the initial responding officers, it then protected SWAT during an extended standoff when the suspect fired 2 shots at the vehicle.

- A suspect in a double homicide was spotted by San Diego PD.
- The suspect fled and was pursued by patrol officers.
- The suspect came to a stop across the street from a school and SWAT was called in.
- A BearCat was used to block the suspect in to prevent escape.
- After a 3 hour standoff the suspect left the car and was forcibly taken into custody.

City Population: 1,394,928

Violent Crime Rate: 4% Below State Average

After a homicide suspect led officers on a high speed pursuit, the BearCat was used to box him in. This prevented further flight and enabled officers to take him into custody.

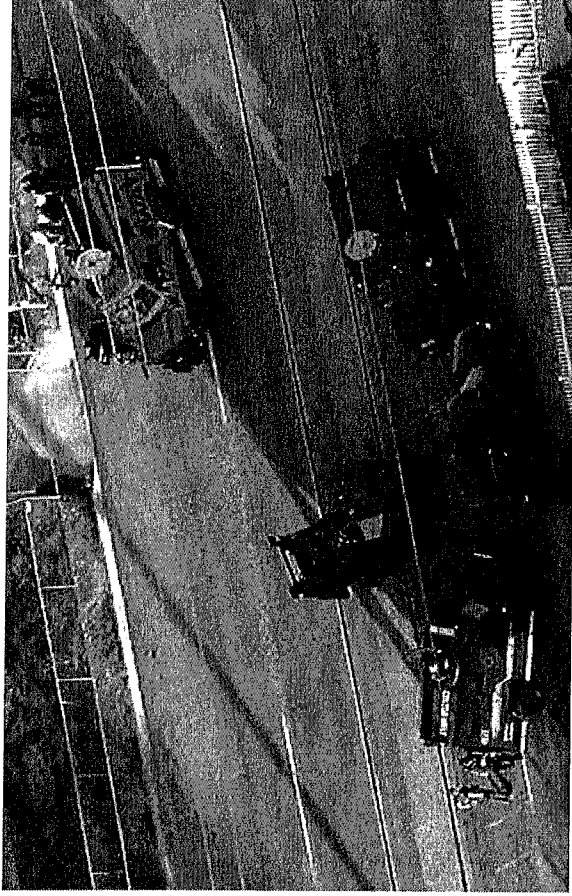

- A male suspect broke into a home and murdered his neighbor.
- The suspect then returned to his own home and set it on fire.
- When fire fighters responded to the house, the suspect fired on them.
- SWAT brought in 2 BearCats to confront and contain the suspect.
- The suspect, attempting to commit suicide by cop, continued to aim a shotgun at officers in the BearCats.
- The suspect eventually drops his weapon and is forcibly taken into custody.

"Due to the ballistic protection provided by the BearCats, we were able to try to contain the suspect. The utilization of the Lenco BearCats was a key element to a successful resolution." Captain John Ott, Monroe County Sheriff's Office

Multiple California Agencies

December 2, 2015

- 2 terrorists opened fire at an office Christmas party, killing 14 and wounding 22.
- Officers searching the area locate the suspects in a black SUV and pursue back into the city.
- 3 BearCats were used to surround the vehicle and protect officers.
- The suspects, armed with assault rifles, fired 76 shots at law enforcement before being killed.

- 3 bondsmen attempt to serve a warrant at a repair shop.
- The suspect immediately started shooting and barricaded himself in a garage.
- SWAT was called in to handle the standoff.
- The suspect immediately fired at a BearCat, hitting it 4-7 times with an AR-15.
- The standoff ended peacefully after 16 hours with no injuries.

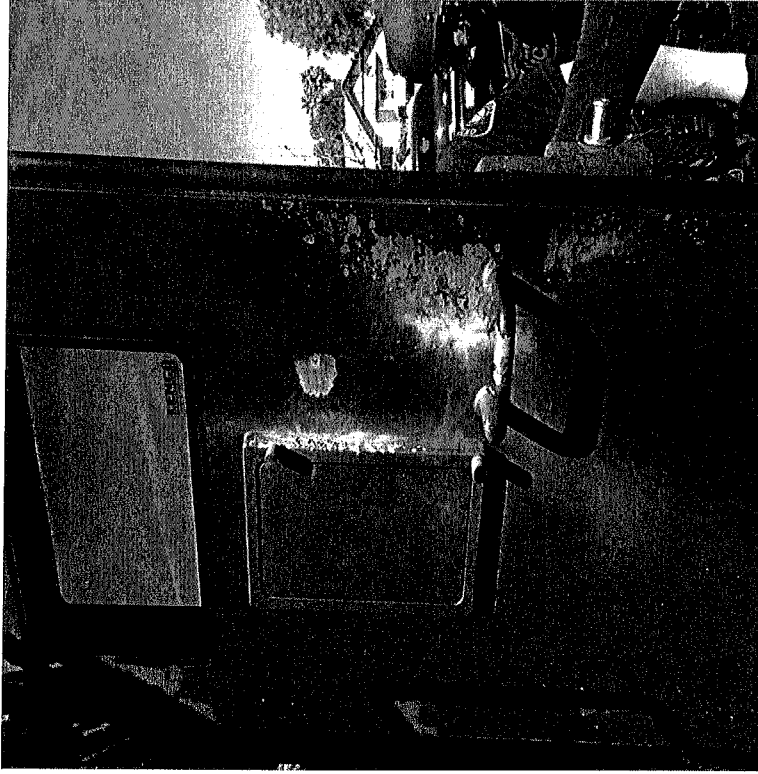

- Suspect barricades himself in apartment with a high powered rifle.
- A SWAT officer is fatally wounded in an alley while setting up a perimeter.
- A BearCat is sent into the alley to attempt to rescue the officer.
- Despite telling negotiators that he'd allow the rescue, the suspect opens fire, hitting the BearCat 15 times.
- After 5 hours, the suspect is found dead of a self inflicted gunshot.

"If it hadn't been on scene last night we would have had a lot more cops wounded or killed. That BearCat, when I say it was a life saver last night I mean it was an absolute life saver." Cass County Sheriff Paul Laney

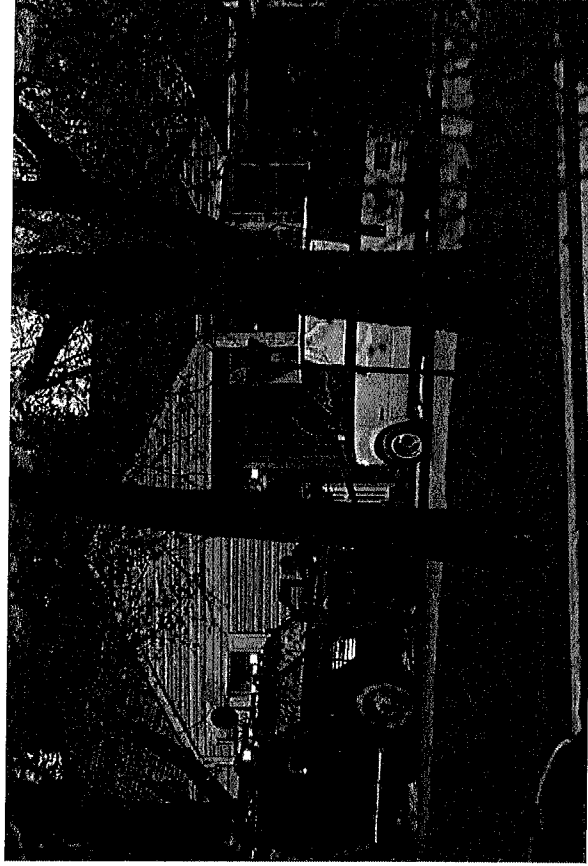

- SWAT brought in a BearCat to secure the front of the house.
- The suspect came to the front of the house and opened fire, hitting the BearCat multiple times.
- SWAT returned fire and deployed chemical agents.
- The suspect set fire to the house and committed suicide.

- A state police BearCat is used to approach the suspect.
- The suspect is shot after leaving his car and pointing the shotgun at police.

- A sniper returned fire, killing the suspect.

When the suspect stepped outside and began shooting, the BearCat was able to help keep all law enforcement personnel on the scene safe.

- After 9 hours, it is discovered that the suspect is dead of a self inflicted gunshot wound.

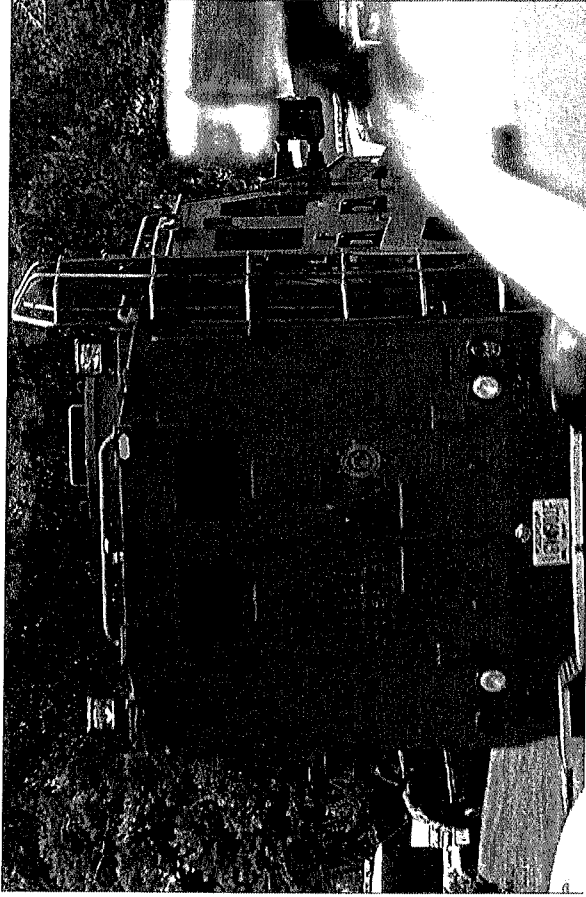

- The suspect is taken into custody after being wounded by the suspect.
