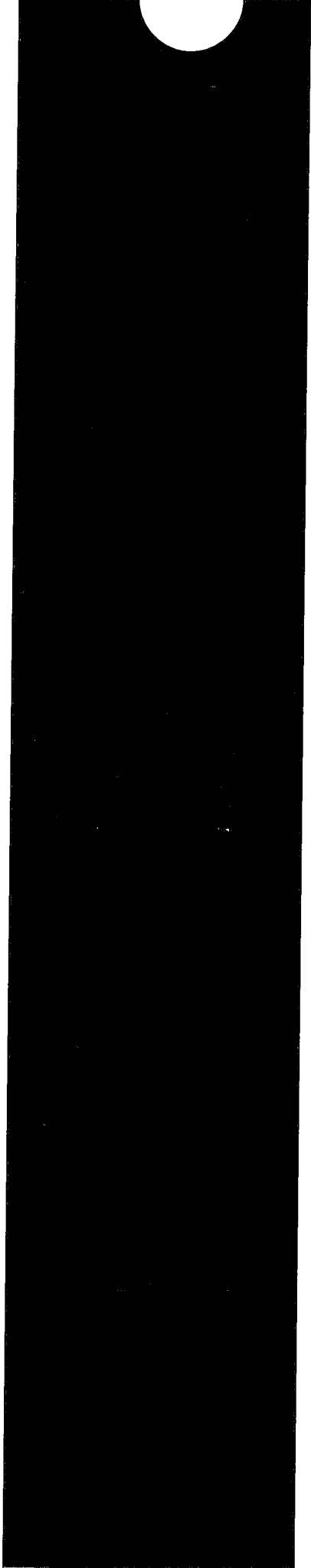


Summit County (Crime)
