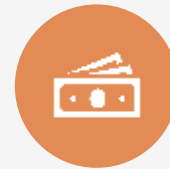

Poor performance in adverse weather conditions

Not rated to stop high caliber rounds

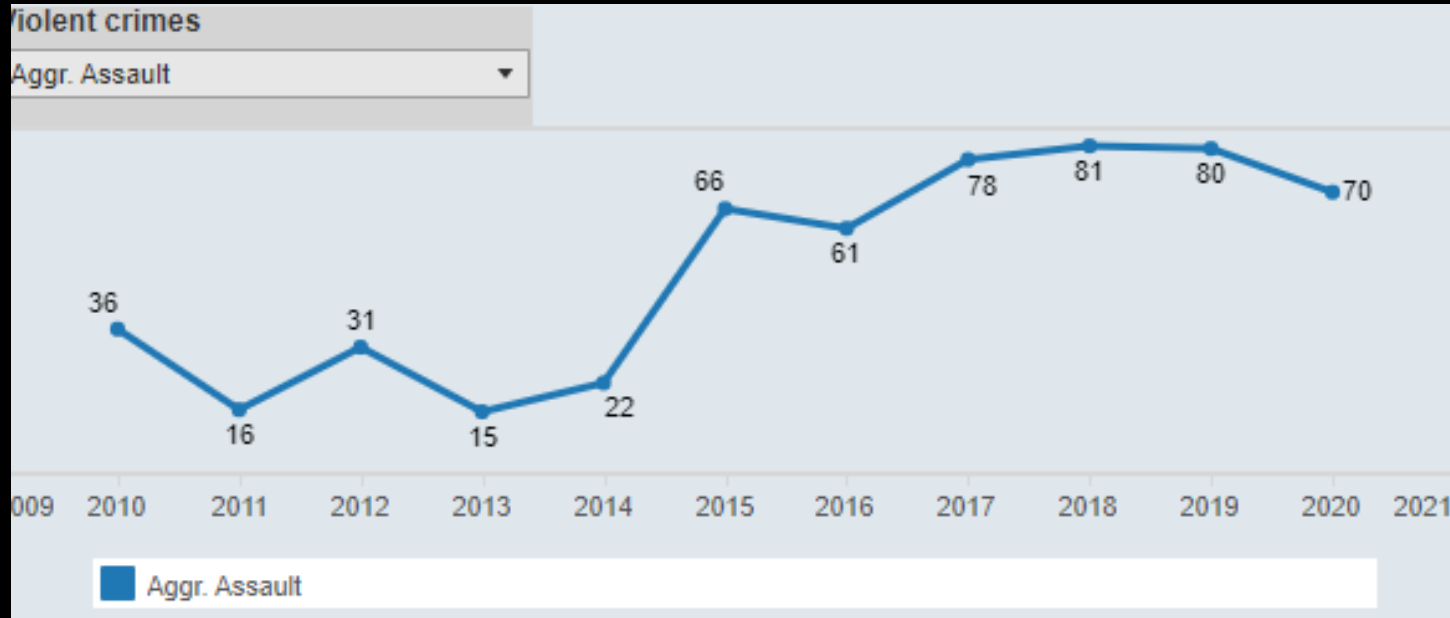
Not available to be accessed by any member of Dillon, Frisco or Silverthorne Police departments

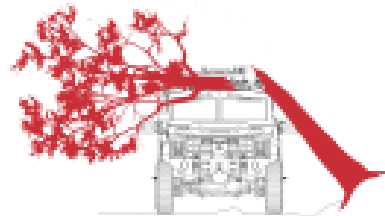

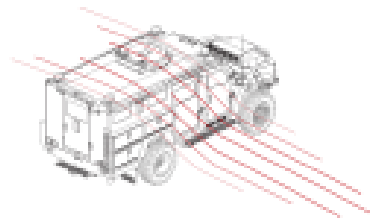
