ORDINANCE 22-13**

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2022 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF FRISCO, COLORADO FOR THE 2023 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Frisco has determined that a mill levy of 0.798 mills upon each dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Frisco is needed to balance the 2023 Town budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FRISCO, COLORADO:

Section 1. For the purposes of defraying the expense of the General Fund of Frisco, Colorado for the fiscal year 2023, there is hereby levied a tax of 0.798 mills upon each dollar of assessed valuation for all taxable property within the Town of Frisco.

Section 2. The Town Clerk is authorized and directed, after adoption of the budget by the Town Council, to certify to the Board of County Commissioners of Summit County, Colorado, the tax levies for the Town of Frisco, Colorado as herein set forth.
