**A RESOLUTION NAMING THE PUBLIC PLACE FOR POSTING NOTICES OF COUNCIL MEETINGS,
COMMISSIONS, AND COMMITTEES FOR THE TOWN OF FRISCO, COLORADO IN COMPLIANCE
WITH THE COLORADO SUNSHINE ACT OF 1972**

WHEREAS, the Colorado Open Meetings Law requires that all meetings at which the adoption of any proposed Town policy or other formal action be held only after full and timely notice to the public; and

WHEREAS, Section 24-6-402(2)(c) requires Town Council to designate a public place for posting notices of any such meetings; and

WHEREAS, this designation must occur annually at the first meeting of each calendar year; and

WHEREAS, Council designates the

- Frisco Town Hall, located at 1 Main Street, has a bulletin board in a location which are open to the public during daytime and evening hours
- Town government website (when technically possible) at FriscoGov.com

as the place for such public notices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FRISCO, COLORADO THAT:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to Section 24-6-402 (2) (c) of the Colorado Revised Statutes, the bulletin board located at Frisco Town Hall at 1 Main Street in the north vestibule, and the Frisco Town government website.

FRISCO, Colorado, hereby designates these as the appropriate places for posting public notices of all regular and special meetings of the Town Council and its designated boards and commissions, unless otherwise designated, for the calendar year 2023.

SECTION 2: All such notices, except those of emergency meetings, shall be posted at these designated places at least 24 hours prior to the holding of the respective meeting.
