**1 IN 3** (OR 10,000) SUMMIT COUNTY RESIDENTS USED FIRC AND BUILDING HOPE SERVICES IN 2022

## DEMOGRAPHICS

The self sufficiency standard for Summit County household of 2.5 is **\$93,962** while FIRC reports an average household income of 2.5 as **\$30,964**. With a high cost of living and low wages, lack of housing, health care, and food costs make Summit County a challenging community to work and raise families. All these factors contribute to high prevalence of stress and poor mental health.

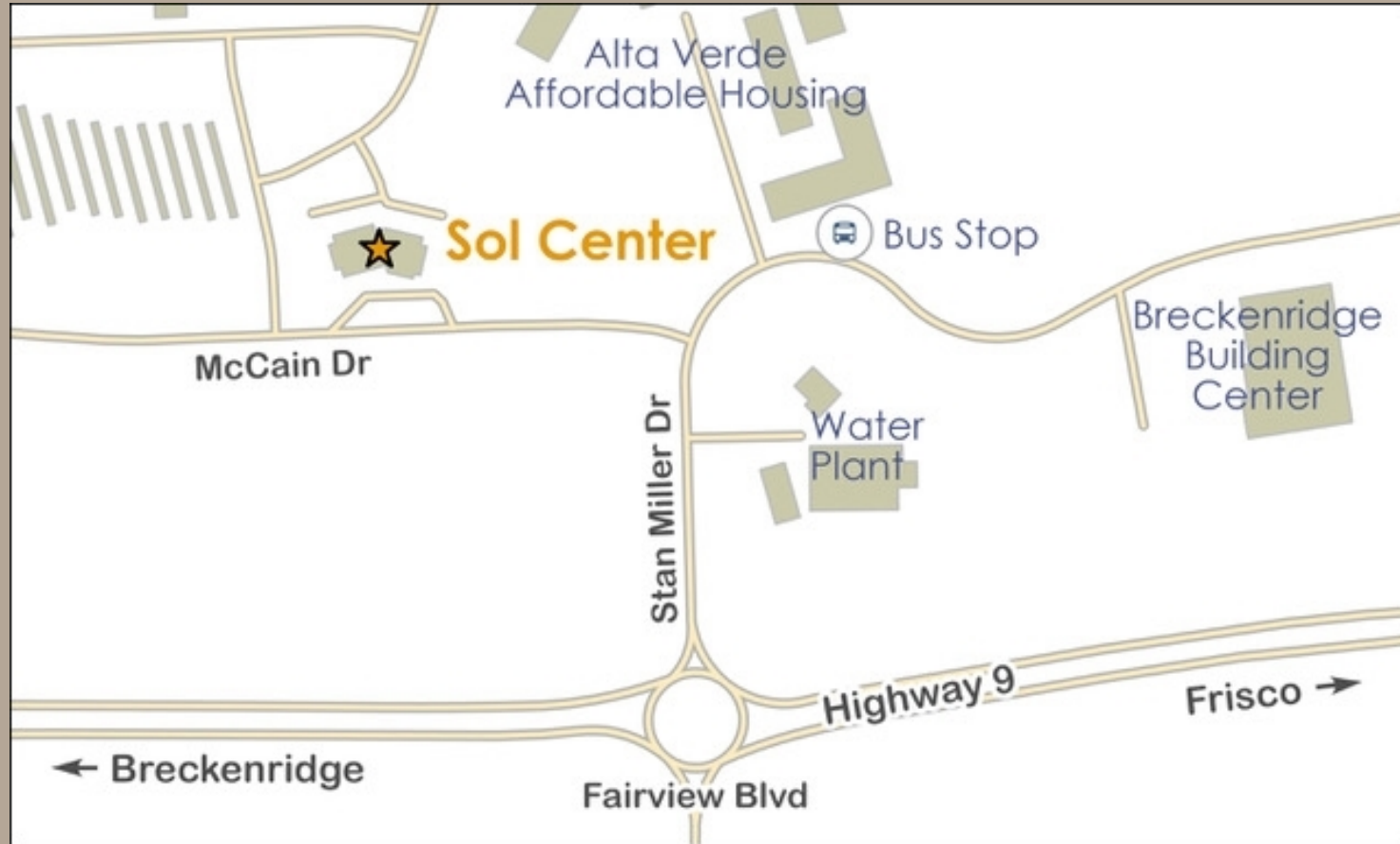
## FOOD, FINANCIAL, PARENT/PEER, COMMUNITY HEALTH

FIRC served **9,992** local workers and family members in 2022 in four main program areas including: Community Food Markets, Financial Empowerment, Parenting & Peer Support, and Community Health.

## MENTAL HEALTH

Since 2018 the Building Hope scholarship program has supported over **15,000** sessions of therapy. Currently 84 providers in our community take Building Hope scholarships. In 2022, Building Hope provided **101** trainings and 15 different support groups serving over **780** individuals through those groups.

**SOL CENTER** will provide robust mental health services with key determinants of health, reducing barriers and promoting strong healthy families and workforce.

**2 in 3** clients live and/or work on the south side of the county.

**Located near Famers Corner within the Alta Verde workforce housing community.**

**18,150 sq ft** will house the thrift store, community food market and offices for FIRC and Building Hope Staff.

**Combining services and operations of the two organization will result in a cost savings of**

**\$200,000 annually** – this savings will go directly back into the community!
