Town Manager Nancy Kerry stated that Council established a Business Assistance Program responding swiftly to the economic crisis brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic in the spring of 2020. Although economic activity in the summer of 2020 was better than predicted, the virus continued to spread around the world and community spread began increasing by the fall of 2020. As expected, this winter, the number of cases and percentage of those positive for the virus, has increased significantly resulting in Public Health Orders closing many businesses to indoor activities and guests. Council recently discussed the potential of establishing another Business Assistance Program to provide economic relief to businesses severely impacted by the current Public Health Orders. Council asked staff to conduct a new business impact survey to gather feedback from local businesses for consideration of a new Business Assistance Program. Information from the survey, as well as staff analysis is offered to provide the Town Council resources to determine the need, and if such a need exists, the criteria from which a program could be developed and implemented. Staffed recommended drafting a general business grant and an innovations grant with specific criteria for eligibility.
