A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION BY THE TOWN OF FRISCO TO THE STATE OF COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS FOR THE ENERGY IMPACT ASSISTANCE FUND: CLIMATE RESILIENCE CHALLENGE GRANT

WHEREAS, the Frisco Town Council adopted the Clean Tracks Steps for a Sustainable Future Action Plan in 2006 with an implementation timeline of 2009-2012; and

WHEREAS, the Frisco Town Council adopted the Summit Community Climate Action Plan in 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Frisco Town Council has identified environmental sustainability goals including net zero as a high priority goal in the Town Council Strategic Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Frisco Town Council adopted the Frisco Partners in Energy: Energy Action Plan on September 13, 2022; and

WHEREAS, a unifying Climate Action Plan would assist Town Staff and Council Members with a clear path forward to achieve goals currently listed in a large number of documents; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Local Affairs (DOLA) administers the Energy Impact Assistance Fund: Climate Resilience Challenge Grant to assist political subdivisions that are socially and/or economically impacted by the development, processing, or energy conversion of minerals and mineral fuels; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Frisco is requesting \$45,000 from DOLA to assist in this important project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FRISCO, COLORADO THAT:

SECTION 1: The Town Council of the Town of Frisco strongly supports the application and has appropriated funds for matching a grant with DOLA.

SECTION 2: The Town Council of the Town of Frisco authorizes the expenditure of funds as necessary to meet the terms and obligations of any grant awarded.

SECTION 3: Partnerships for this Project will be secured upon award of grant funding.

SECTION 4: This resolution to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
