<u>Summary and Background:</u> Town Council was approached by a diverse group of artists to paint a mural supporting Black Lives Matter on the Town of Frisco Main Street. Support from the community for this project led Council to believe that social equity should be further investigated.

Mayor Mortensen and Council Member Sherburne met with Town Manager, Nancy Kerry, and Human Resources Manager, Loli Respini-Pollard, on September 10th to discuss Council's expectations on this topic. During this meeting, it became evident that members of the community needed to be involved in social equity discussions.

A presentation to Council was done on November 10^{th,} 2020. Council approved moving this project forward by supporting the National League of Cities comprehesive training.

Analysis: Not at this time.

Financial Impact: The cost of the training is \$17,877.

<u>Alignment with Strategic Plan:</u> This projects aligns with Town Council Inclusive Community; create comprehensive policies to address social equity plan.
