RE:	COUNTY COMMONS EQR REQUIREMENTS FOR FUTURE PROJECTS (UPDATED)

On January 9, 2018, the Town and County signed the First Amendment (2018 agreement) to the IGA for Water Services dated September 24, 2001 (2001 agreement). This 2018 agreement entitles the County to a credit for an additional 133.33 EQR's on top of the original amount of 171.64 EQRs provided in the 2001 agreement for a current total of 304.97 EQR's.

The 1994 Agreement adds an additional 38 EQR's **<u>but no water rights were brought with that</u>** <u>agreement</u>.

Total EQR's from all three agreements is 342.97. All agreements now provide 9.2 acre / feet of senior Clinton reservoir water that have been added to the Towns water rights portfolio.
