RESOLUTION 21-16**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FRISCO, COLORADO, ADOPTING THE EV READINESS IN SUMMIT COUNTY” PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF FRISCO

WHEREAS, transportation is responsible for 33 percent of greenhouse gas emissions in Summit County and is now the leading source of carbon pollution in Colorado and the United States; and

WHEREAS, Frisco adopted the Summit Community Climate Action Plan in 2018, which set goals to reduce countywide greenhouse gas emissions 50 percent by 2030 and 80 percent by 2050; and

WHEREAS, the Climate Action Plan also established a goal to increase electric vehicle (EV) adoption in Summit County, so that by 2030, there are over 10,000 EVs registered in the community; and

WHEREAS, EV sales are projected to double in the United States within the next five years, and our communities must be prepared to support an increasing number of EV drivers; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Frisco has already taken action to encourage EV use, such as installing public EV charging infrastructure, and requiring installation of EV infrastructure for new construction projects.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Frisco hereby adopts the “EV Readiness in Summit County” plan prepared by the Summit Climate Action Collaborative and dated April 2021.
