- Expand and modernize the children’s reading and creative areas.
- Create spaces that accommodate the needs of children, young adults, families, and an increasingly linguistically and culturally diverse community.
- Provide opportunities for integrating technology.
- Creation of a library facility that serves as a vibrant center for learning and creativity at the heart of the community.

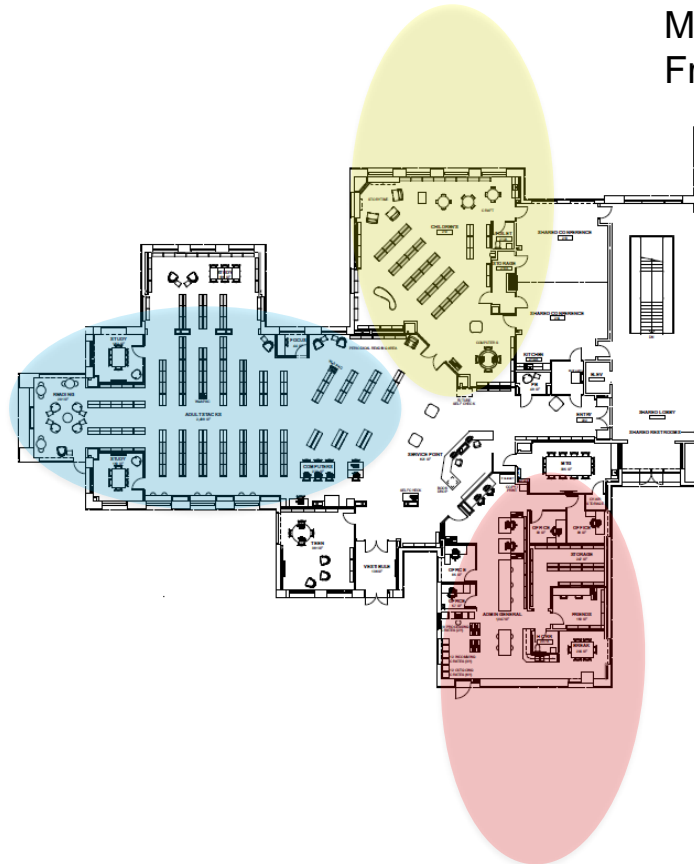

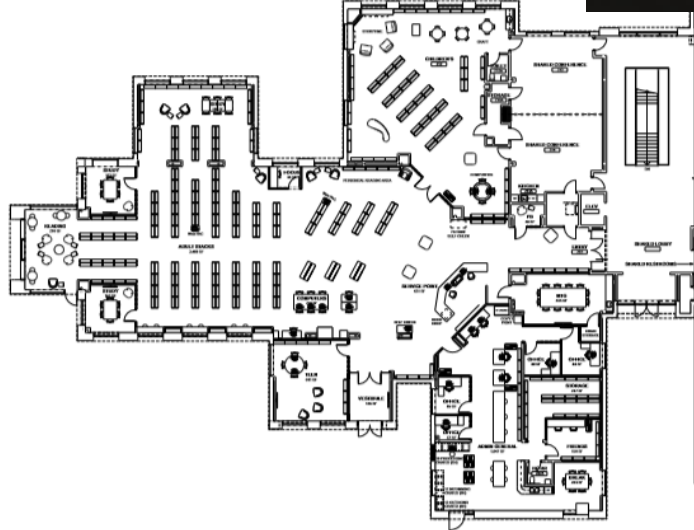

#### **Study Room each**

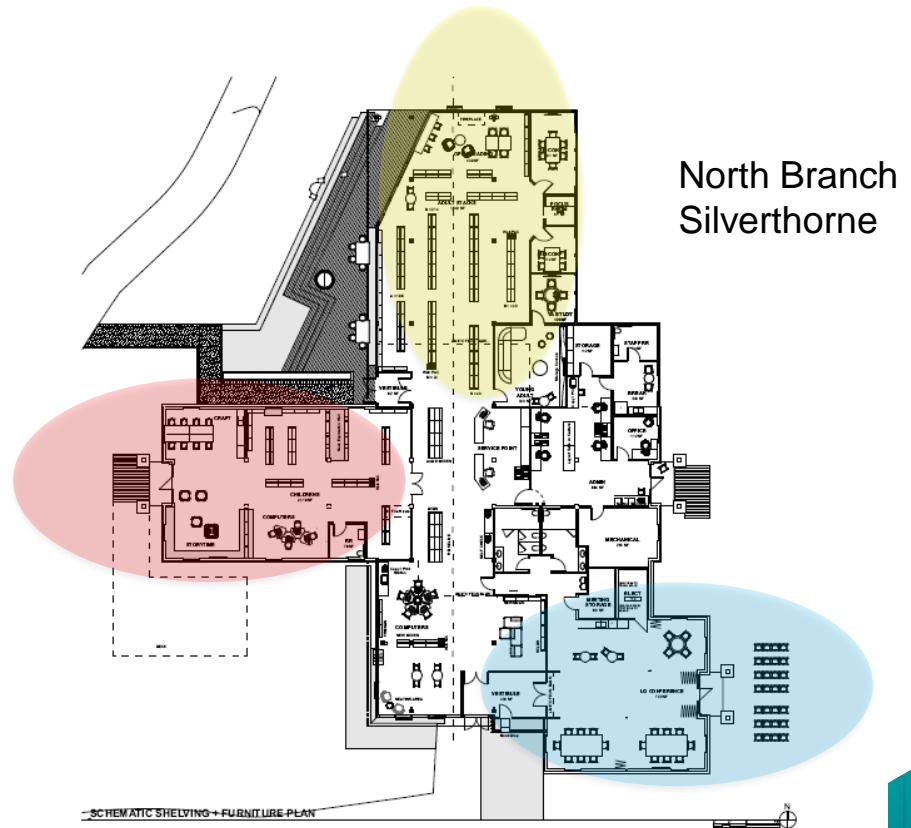
Small learning and meeting room conveniently accessed from the adult area, where individuals or groups can work collaboratively while tapping into the libraries wireless access.

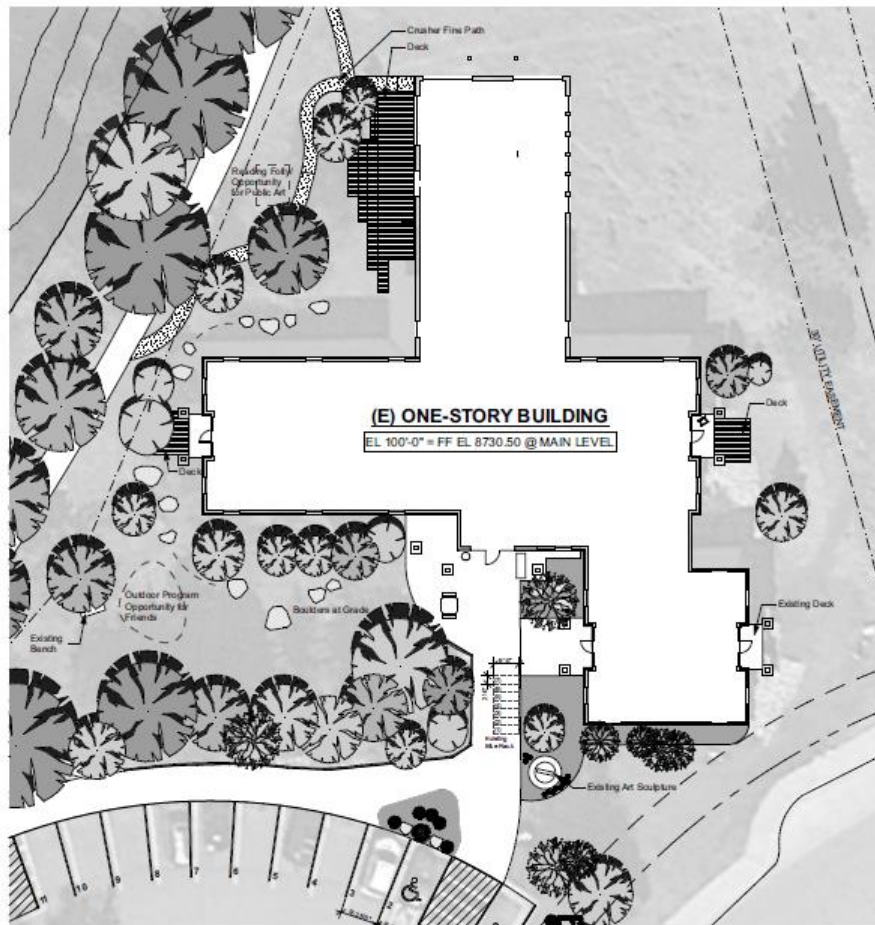
