**Subject:** Officers save an OD

Chief-

Tonight, Officers responded to the area of the 6<sup>th</sup> and Main for an overdose. The caller did not give a location, but when Officer Velasquez and Officer Elmgreen arrived on scene, they heard a male shouting for help on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Snowshoe hotel. Officers ran to the location (exterior hallway) and found a 39 y/o female suffering from an overdose. Officer Elmgreen and Officer Velasquez began checking for a pulse and breathing, but only found a faint pulse that was in and out. The female was blue in color. Officer Elmgreen administered a dose of Narcan to the female. Officers checked for a pulse and breathing but still did not find either. Officer Velasquez administered another dose of Narcan and Officer Elmgreen began to detect a pulse. She was placed into the recovery position while Officer Elmgreen monitored her breathing and pulse. She then woke up and told us that she was fine (Narcan is amazing). EMS arrived on scene and took her to SMC for treatment. The Officer did a good job recognizing what was happening and taking quick action to save the overdosed victim's life. Upon follow up at SMC, she was just upset that we took her drugs...
