

Frisco BBQ Challenge

Survey 2021





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Survey Objectives

- **Why?**
 - The Town of Frisco wanted to have a better understanding of community opinions on the BBQ Challenge. The Challenge had been discontinued because of COVID-19 and there was recognition of an opportunity to reevaluate the event.
 - Business owners, residents, second homeowners and visitors' opinions were all of interest. Are they aligned or are there differences between groups?
- **What?**
 - What are the ratings of various aspects of the event?
 - How satisfied were respondents? What comments did the groups provide?
- **How?**
 - A web-based survey widely publicized by Town staff.
 - RRC was hired to assist in analyzing data collected by the Town.



Methodology

A total of 1,793 surveys were obtained via a widely publicized Survey Monkey-based effort. The responses were designed to target a range of different segments of the community including business owners, residents within the Town, residents living elsewhere in Summit County and the Front Range, as well as some destination visitors from out of state that chose to respond.

After shutting off the survey and collecting the associated data, the Town requested assistance from RRC Associates, an independent firm that specializes in surveys and data collection for communities. This report represents a summary of findings. A series of slides summarize responses from the various segments of participants and observations of notable patterns in the data are presented. In addition, a series of Key Findings are provided as a summary of survey results that may be useful to support, as upcoming discussions.

A total of 1,793 surveys were fully or partially completed. As is typical for these types of surveys, not all of the respondents that start the survey complete it. However, partial surveys have been included in this analysis. The individual slides show the number of responses on each question as designated by the abbreviation including 443 paper surveys returned, as well as 249 surveys filled out using the digital invitation. This return represented 615 households, with 74 households having two respondents that completed the survey.

Key Findings

- The survey results were analyzed in total (the “Overall”) as well as by subgroups of respondents (resident type, time owning or living in Frisco, etc.). The variable that the team determined to be of greatest interest was whether the respondent reported they owned a business in Frisco. The following slides segment responses by those that “Own” and “Do not own a business.” About 14% of respondents report that they own a business in Frisco.
- A large percentage of both business owners and non-business owners have attended the BBQ Challenge in the past five years. In other words, survey respondents are familiar with the event. The survey also asked what aspects of the Challenge are most typically attended. BBQ/food, music and meeting with friends were most identified by business owners and non-owners.
- Among business owners over half (56%) report they own on Main Street. There is also a large segment (33%) that report working from home.
- Business owners were most likely to report that the BBQ Challenge had a positive impact on business. About 30% reported no impact, and one in five (20%) said there was a negative impact. Most restaurant/bar owners reported a positive impact, while retail business owners were most likely to cite a negative impact (50% of that group calling it negative).
- Nearly three quarters (73%) of business owners believe the effect of past BBQ Challenges has been positive or very positive from a public relations and community standpoint. Fourteen percent believe the impact has been negative/very negative, while 14% are neutral. Business owners on Main Street gave comparable but slightly more negative responses.

Key Findings

- Both business owners and non-owners were asked to rate their satisfaction with the event. Business owners were less likely to be satisfied/dissatisfied than residents (69% compared to 85%), but the key finding is that both groups were generally satisfied. Overall, 9% expressed dissatisfaction (1/2 on the five points scale). Business owners on Main Street were slightly more negative (23% rating it a 1 /2 compared to 14% of business respondents from other areas).
- Of interest, residents of Frisco, and residents of Summit County express greatest dissatisfaction (15% and 12%) respectively, but even among these segments those that were satisfied far exceeded those dissatisfied.
- In a potentially important question, 87% of respondents that do not own businesses in Frisco would “like to see the event remain in Frisco.” About 64% of business owners recorded this opinion, but with 9% unsure. One in five business owners (22%) said they would not like to see the BBQ event remain in Frisco. Importantly, while 73% of full time Frisco residents would like to see the event remain in Frisco, and 82% of Summit County residents feel this way, respondents from beyond Summit County (including second homeowners) are strongly in favor of the event remaining in Frisco (93% to 97%). For these respondents there is very strong support for the Challenge in Frisco, it appears to provide a source of activity and entertainment that is positively (and maybe uniquely) associated with the Town.
- About 75% of respondents overall are satisfied with the date of the event, and 20% are “neutral/don’t care.” In other words, there is general support for the timing of the Challenge, but with slightly more business owners preferring a different date. Among those preferring a different date, September was most identified. The survey also probed various aspects of the event including music, activities for children and the size of the Challenge. These results are presented in the report.

Key Findings

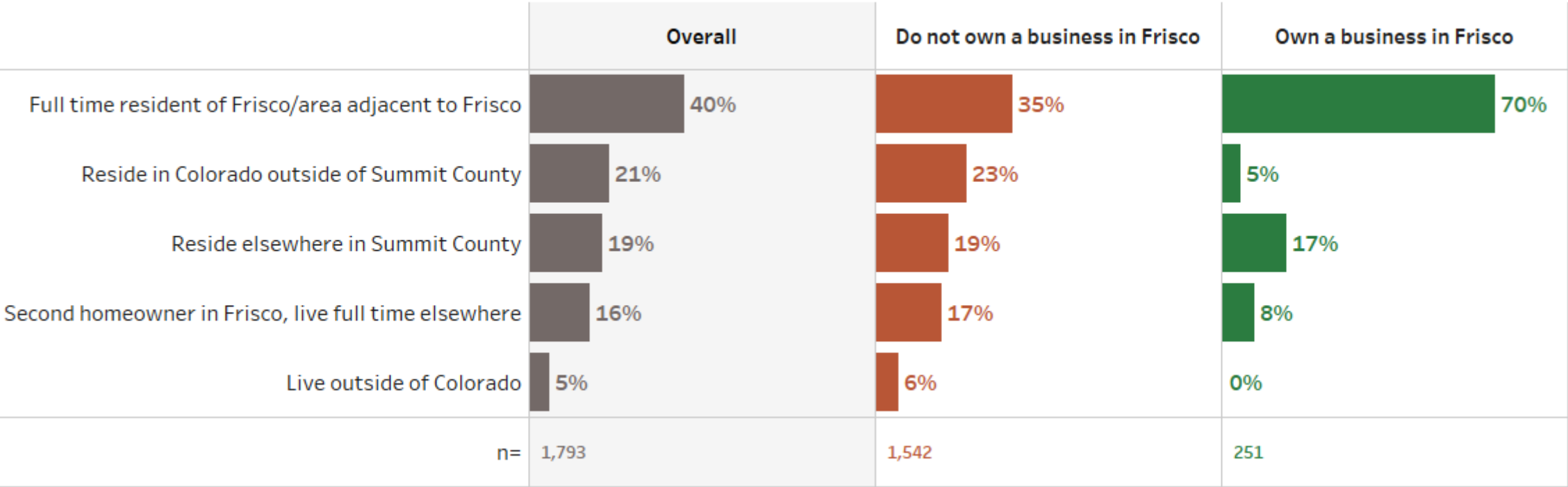
- The survey indicates that a segment of respondents “volunteer” for the Challenge. The importance of this element of the event should not be overlooked, it is one of the ways that Frisco residents and business owners can work together, and it can be a source of pride and local energy. Perhaps there are even greater opportunities to grow this element of the Challenge?
- The survey elicited over 800 open ended comments on the single question, “Are there other suggestions that you would like Frisco Town Council to consider as they discuss the BBQ Challenge in the future?” The comments include some strong opinions from those that are opposed to the event for a variety of reasons. However, the quantitative results from the survey indicate that these opinions are in the minority. These comments should be considered, as well as many that contain suggestions for improvement or “tweaks” to the event. Taken together, there is clearly an opportunity to use community input to continue to refine the BBQ Challenge if it is continued in the future.

Respondent Type

Overall, 40% of respondents are full-time residents of Frisco (35% of non-business owners and 70% of business owners). Just 5% of all respondents live out-of-state.

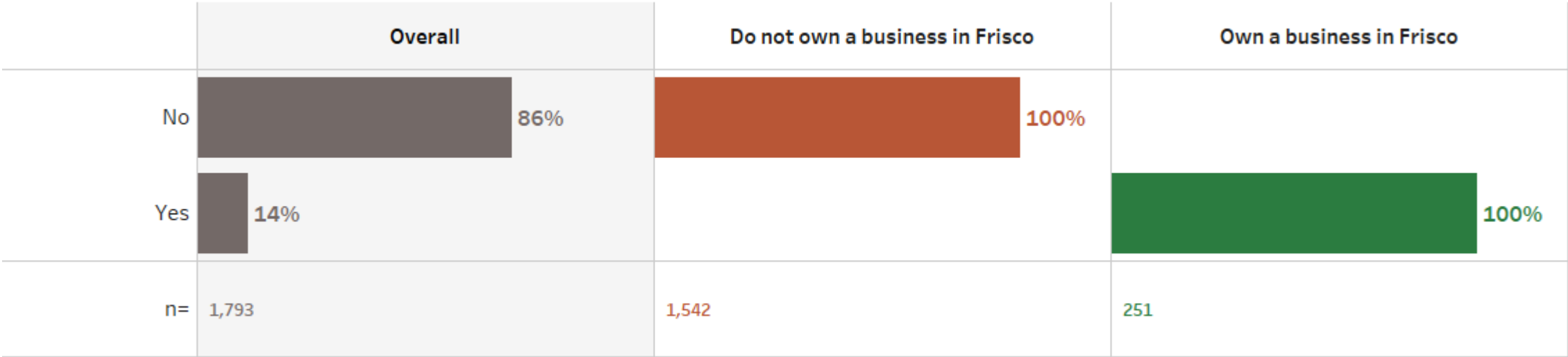

Q: Do you own a business in Frisco?



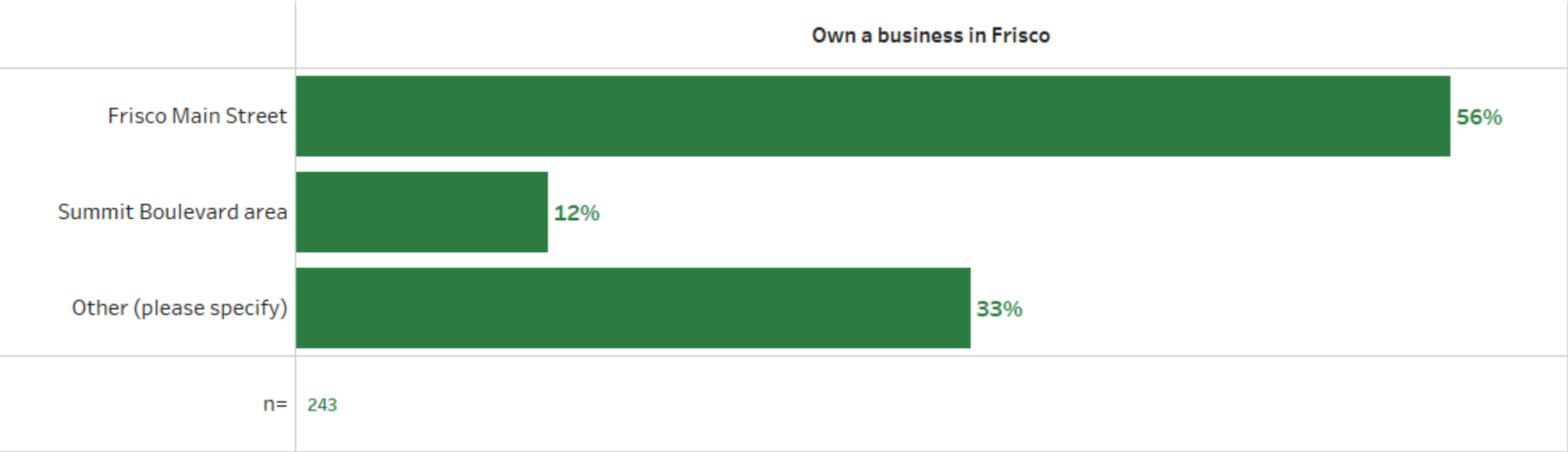

Q: Where is your business located? (Check all that apply)



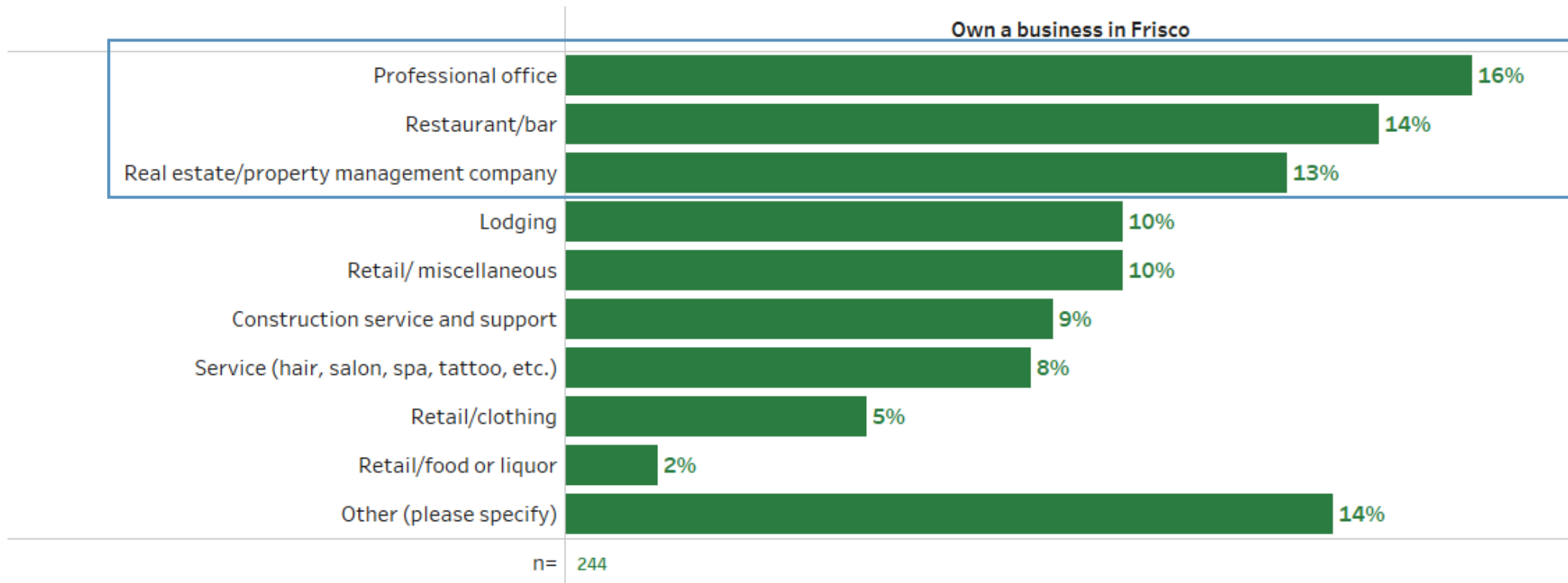

Q: Type of business



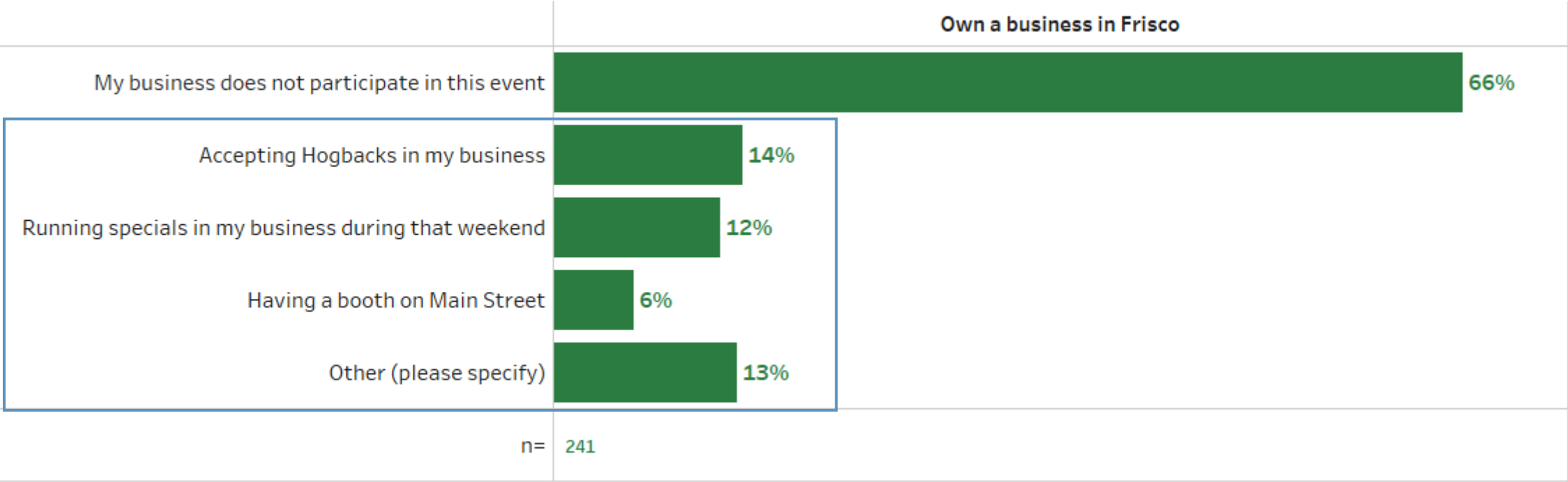

Q: My business participates in the Colorado BBQ Challenge by: (Check all that apply)



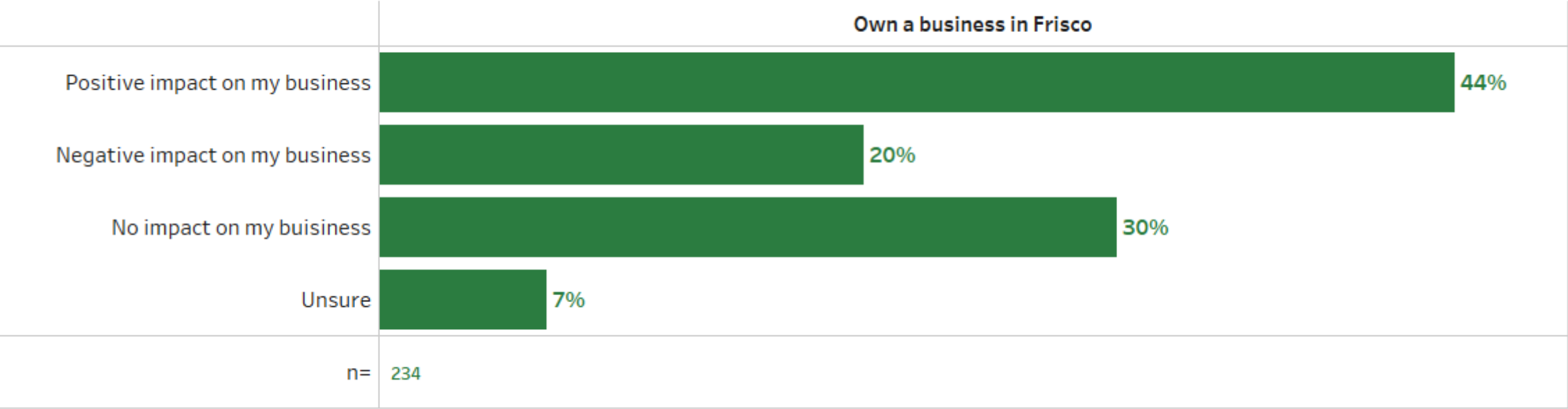

Impact of BBQ Challenge on Business

Q: I believe that over the 2 days of BBQ Challenge the event has a:



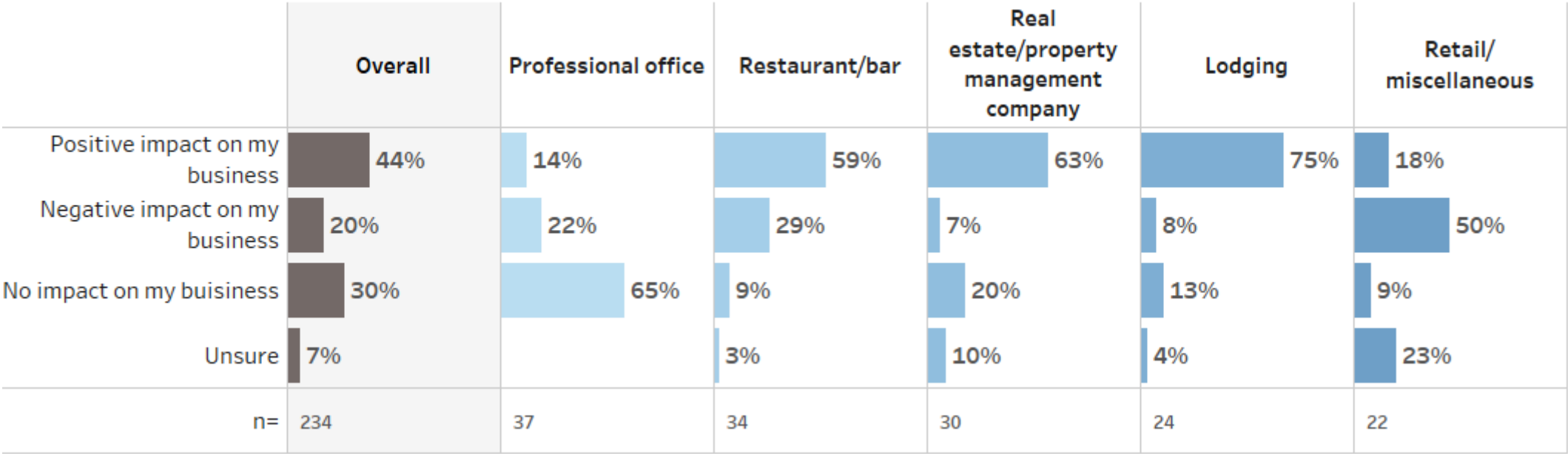

Impact of BBQ Challenge on Business

By Business Type

Some caution should be used when interpreting results by business type due to low sample sizes; however, respondents in the real estate and lodging sectors are more likely to report positive impacts from the event. While most restaurant/bar owners report positive impacts (59%), they also report a relatively high share of negative impacts (29%). Retail business owners are most likely to report negative impacts (50%).

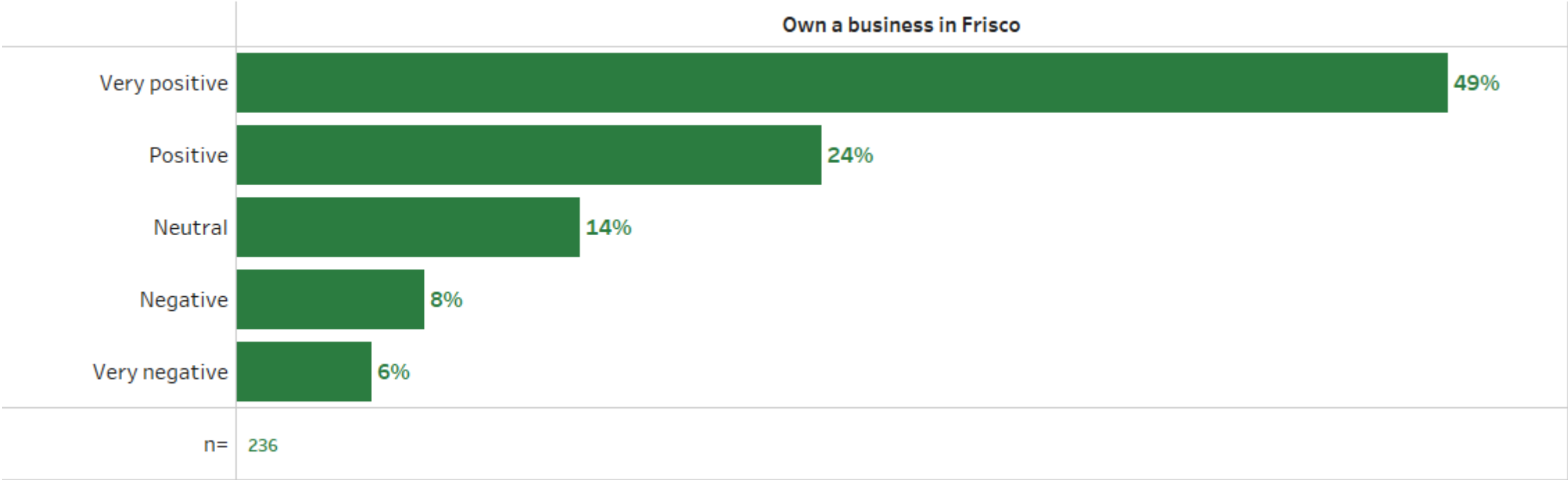

Q: Are you satisfied with the overall event profile, including activities, signage, noise/music, hours, etc. on Main Street?



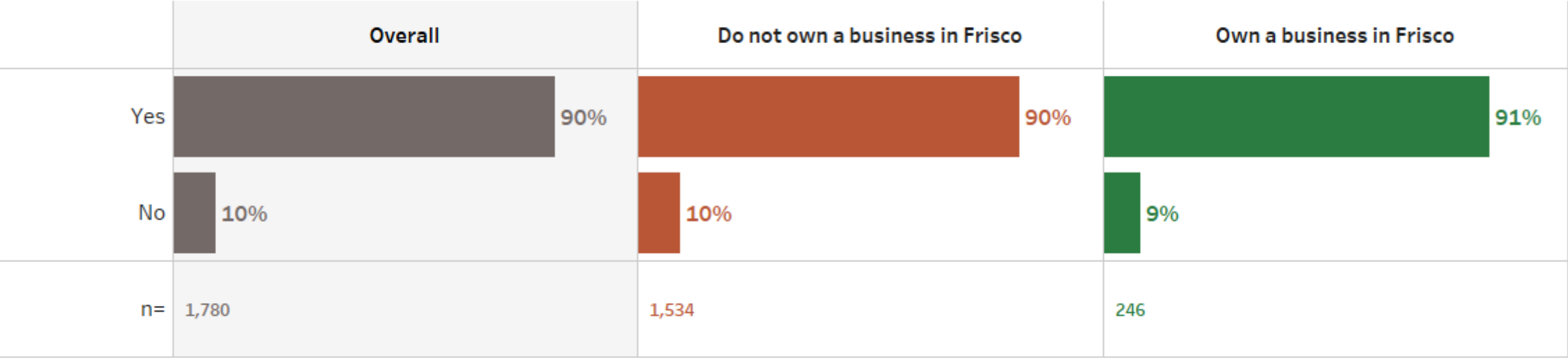

Q: Have you attended the BBQ Challenge in the past 5 years?



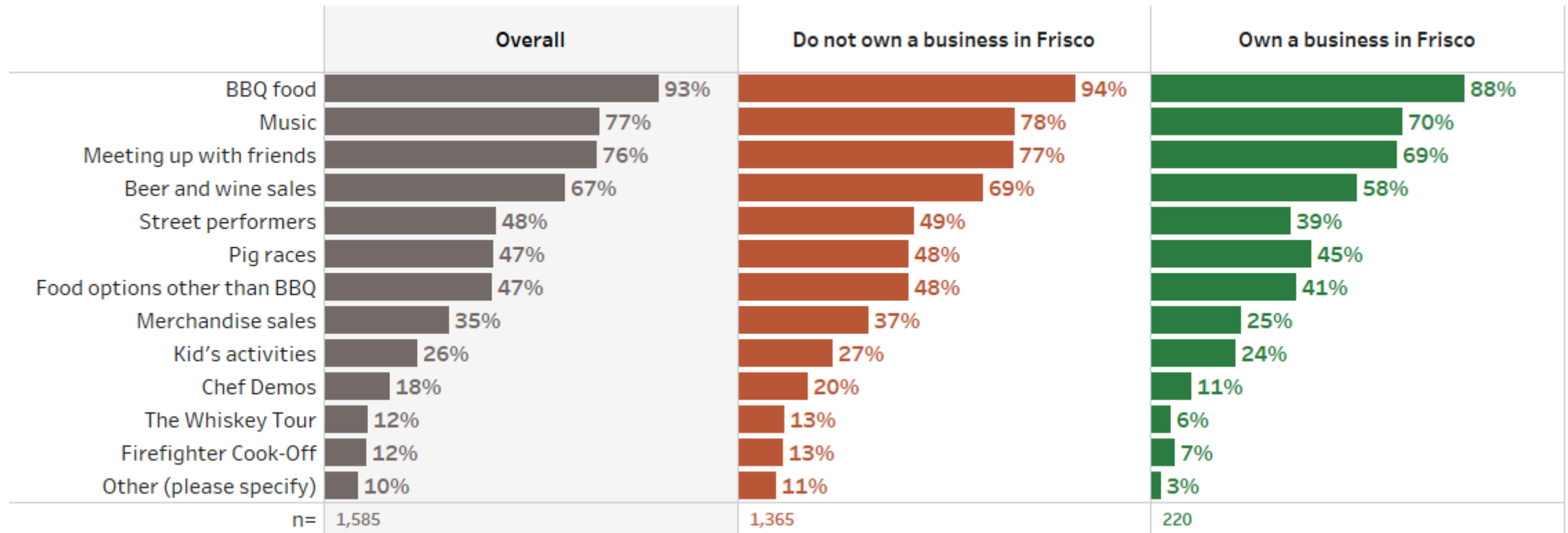

Satisfaction Ratings Combined

By Respondent Type

Five questions throughout the survey asked respondents to rate their satisfaction on a scale from “1 – Very dissatisfied” to “5 – Very satisfied.” This figure shows the average (mean) ratings of each of those questions in one view, with a crosstab by respondent type. Respondents were most satisfied with the overall event, and least satisfied with kids’ activities (however the low satisfaction for kids’ activities was driven largely by a high share of neutral responses). For each question, ratings were higher among non-Summit County residents relative to Frisco/Summit County residents.

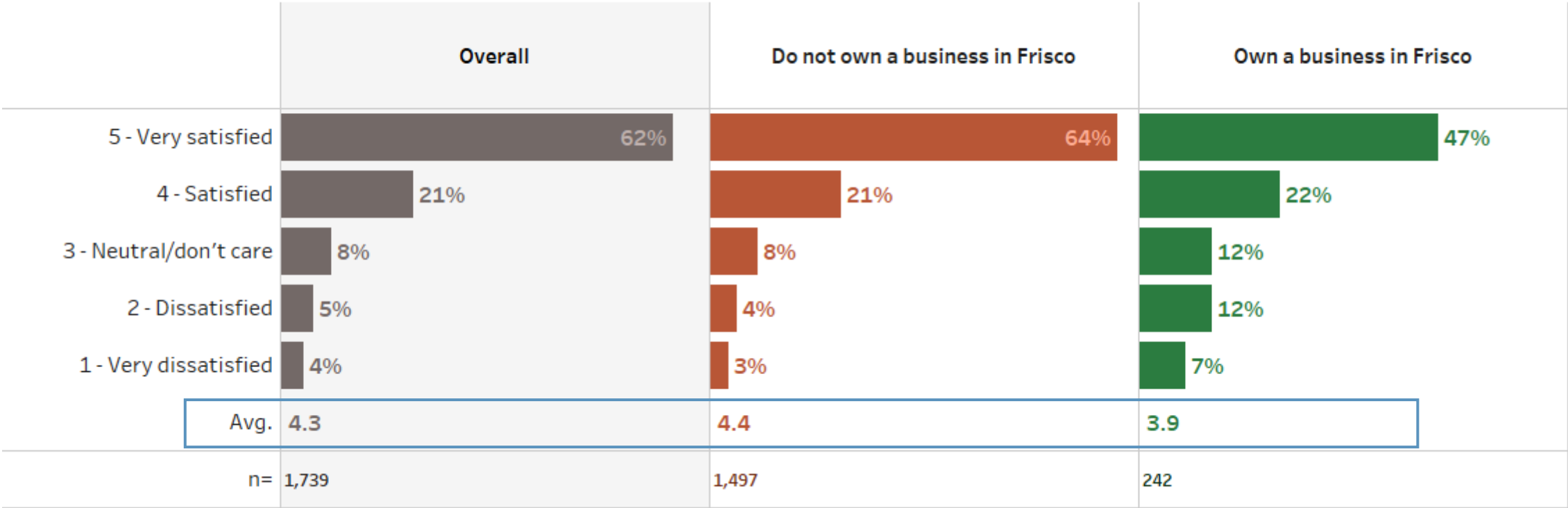

Satisfaction with Event

By Business Ownership

Overall, respondents reported a high degree of satisfaction with the event. On a five-point scale from “1 – Very dissatisfied” to “5 – Very satisfied,” the average rating 4.3. It was slightly higher among non-business owners (4.4) than business owners (3.9).

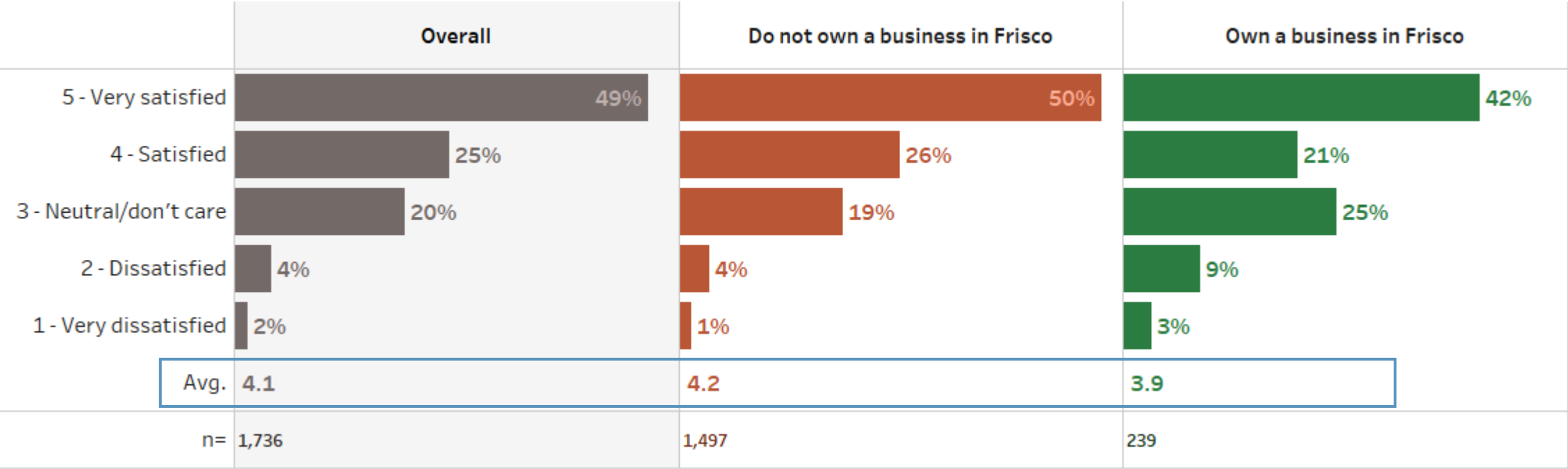

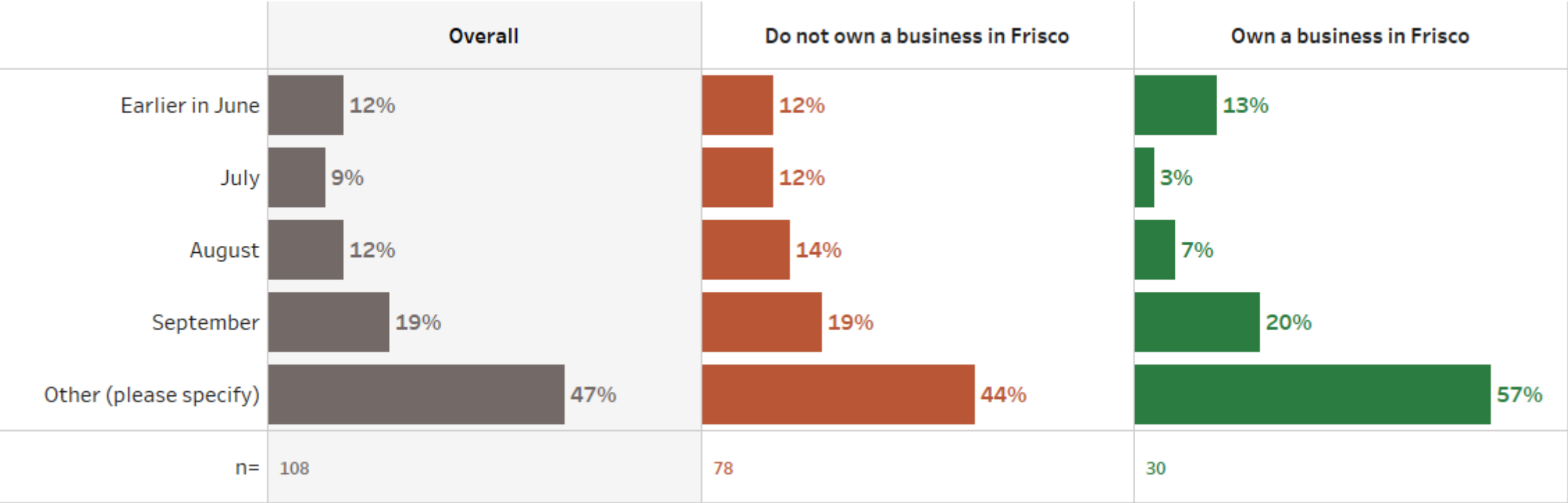

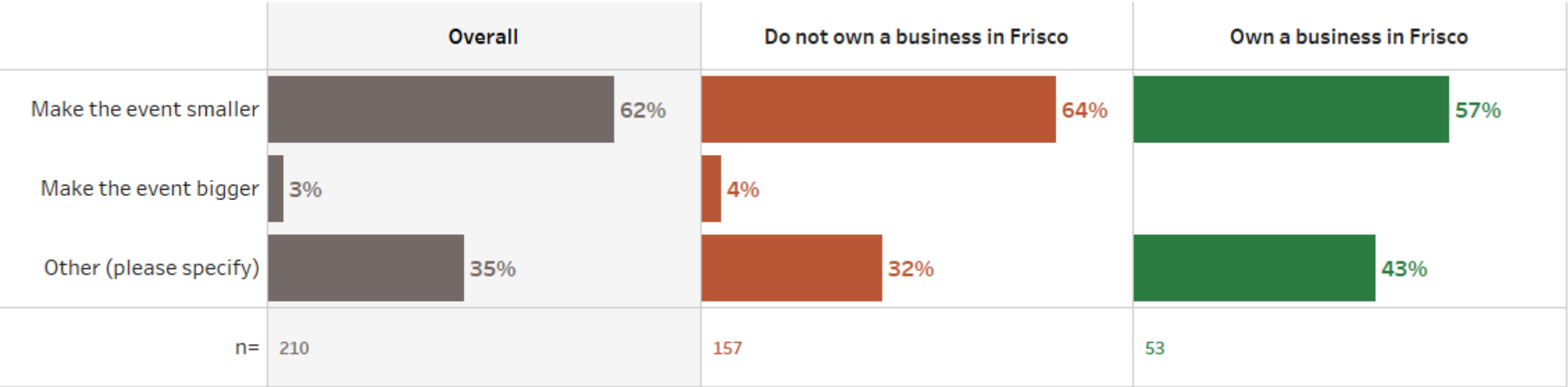

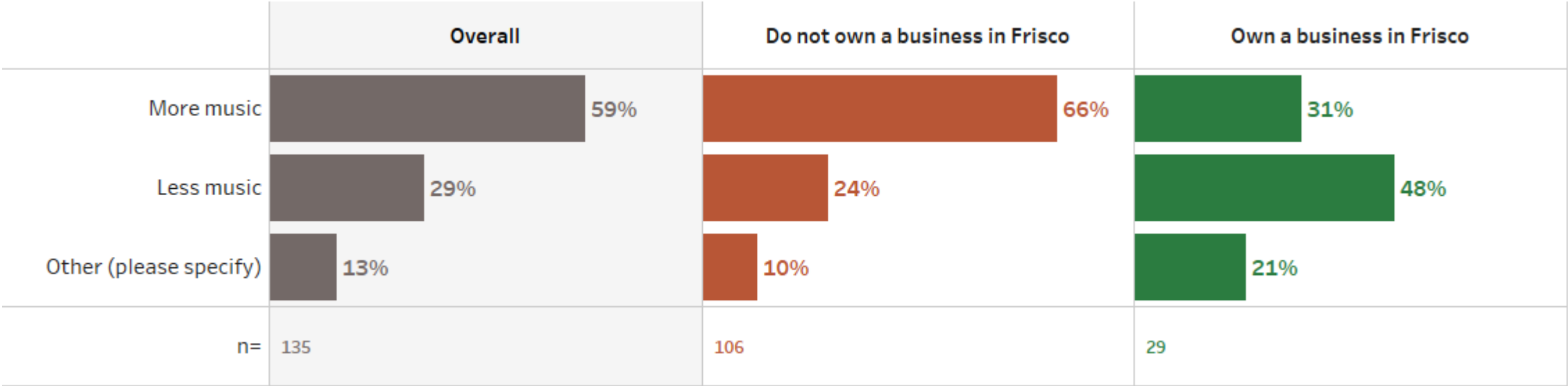

Q: What changes to the amount of music would make you more satisfied?



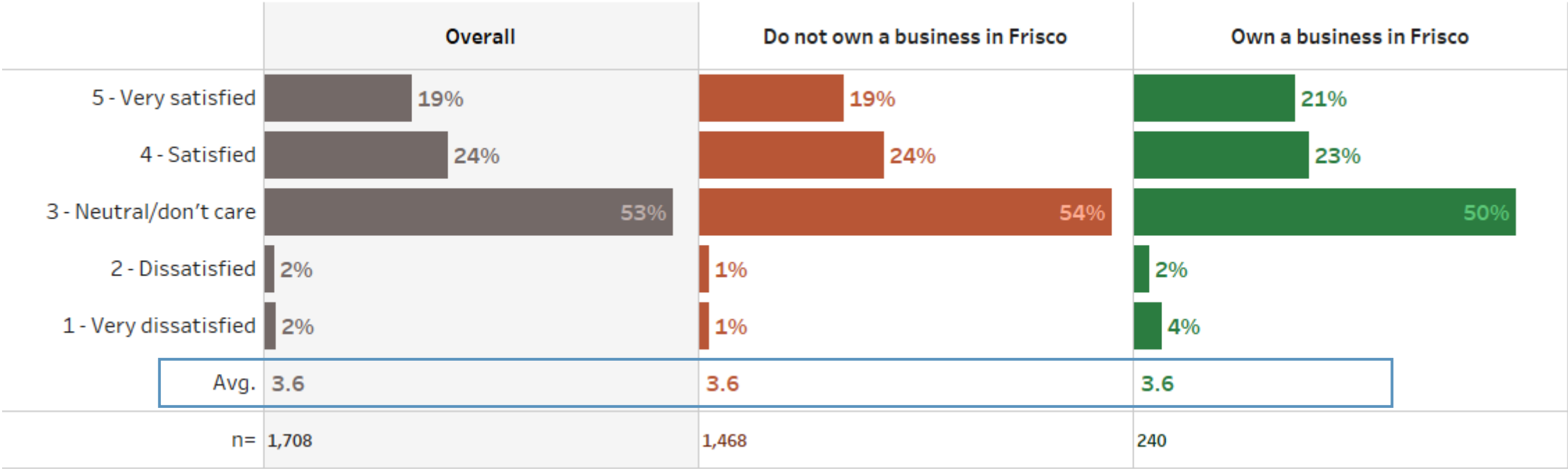

Q: How satisfied are you with the kids' activities at the event?



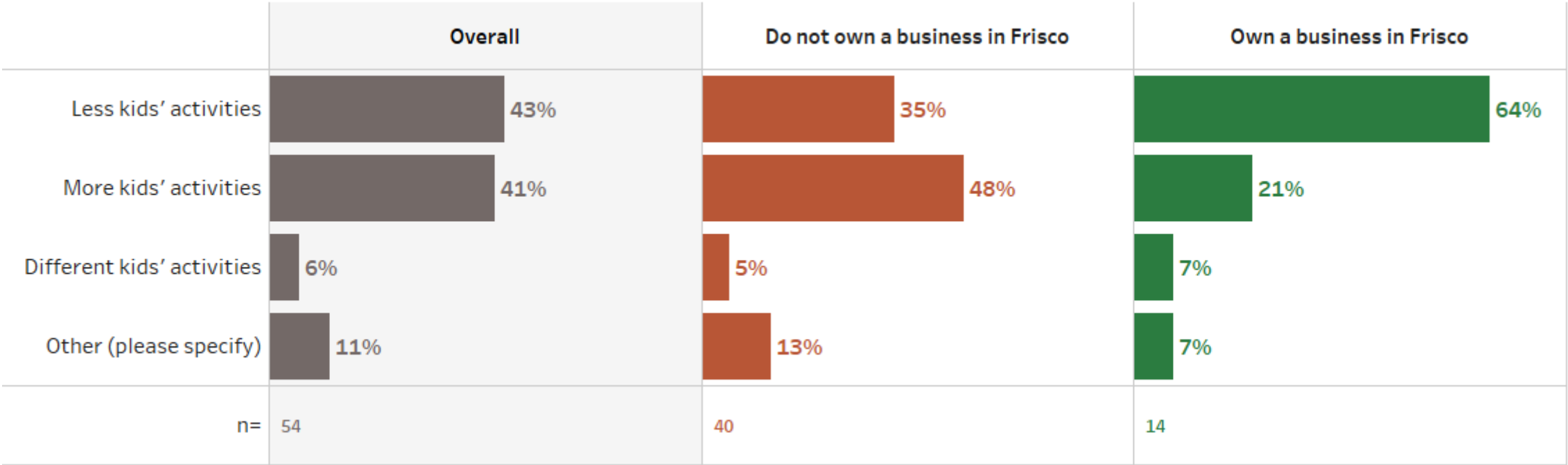

Q: What changes to the kids' activities would make you more satisfied?



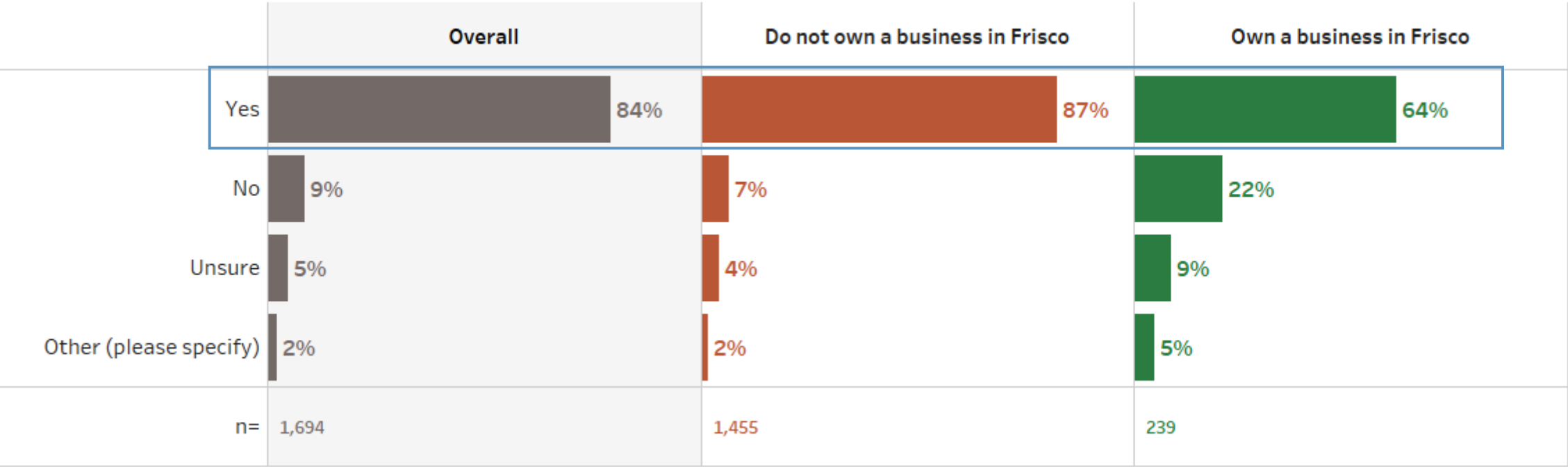

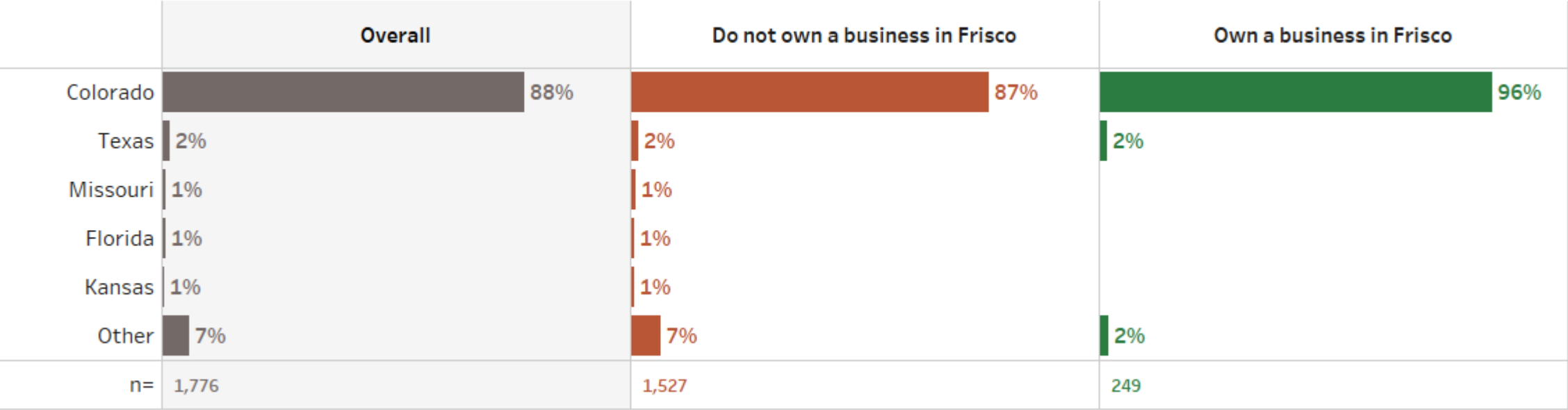

Respondent State (Top 5)

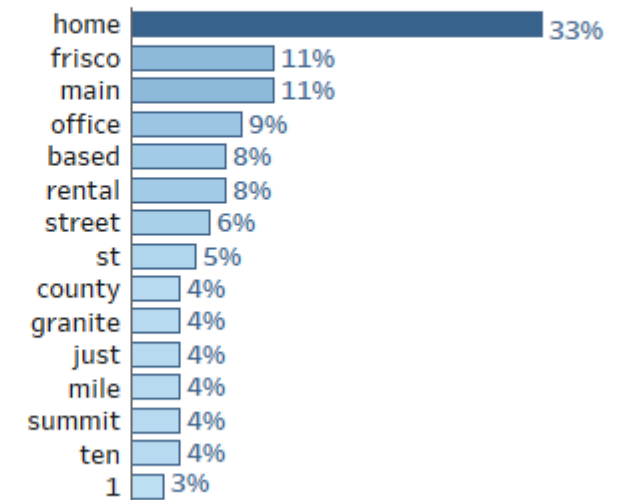
Respondents were most likely to be from Colorado (88%), followed by Texas (2%). All other states were comprised of 1% or fewer of total respondents.

Q: State/ Country



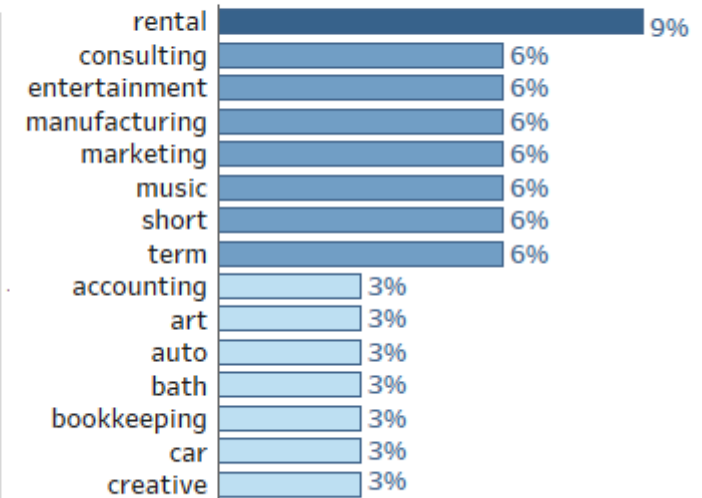

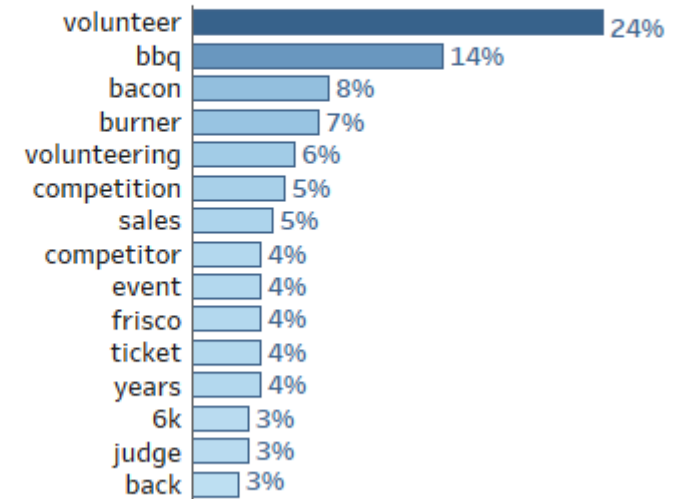

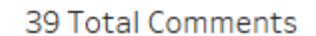

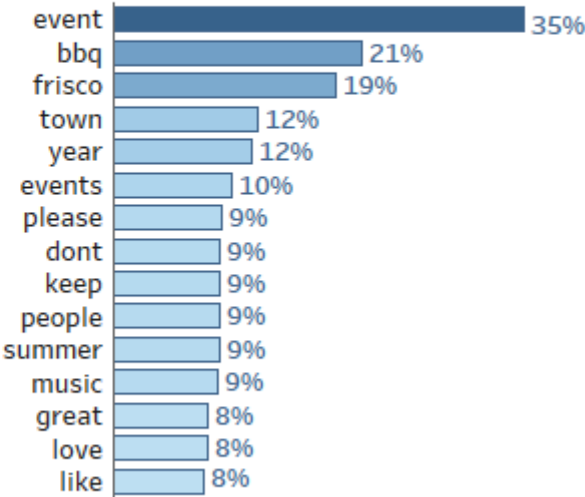
