RE: ORDINANCE 21-07, ADOPTING THE NFPA NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE (NEC), 2020 EDITION, BY REFERENCE.
DATE: JUNE 8, 2021

Summary and Background: This is first reading of Ordinance 21-07. The purpose of this ordinance is to update the Town's construction codes to the latest published edition of NFPA 70 National Electric Code. There are no amendments proposed to the code.

Analysis: NFPA updates the National Electric Code every three years, which is then adopted by the Colorado State Electrical Board. Colorado Revised Statutes requires all jurisdictions with their own code enforcement departments, to enforce the latest edition of State Electrical Code, as adopted by the State Electrical Board. Adoption of Ordinance 21-07 enables the Town to remain in compliance with CRS.

Financial Impact: Adoption of Ordinance 21-07 will have no direct financial impact to the budget.

Alignment with Strategic Plan: This ordinance aligns with Town Council's Quality Core Services.

Environmental Sustainability: Adoption of Ordinance 21-07 will have no direct effect on environmental sustainability.

Staff Recommendation: Staff recommends the Town Council adopt Ordinance 21-07 on first reading.
