RE: SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE 21-07, ADOPTION OF THE NFPA 2020

NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE (NEC)

DATE: JULY 13, 2021

<u>Summary and Background:</u> This is the second reading of Ordinance 21-07. The purpose of this ordinance is to update the Town's construction codes to the latest published edition of NFPA 70 National Electric Code. There are no amendments proposed to this code, and first reading was approved on June 8, 2021.

<u>Analysis:</u> NFPA updates the National Electric Code every three years, which is then adopted by the Colorado State Electrical Board. Colorado Revised Statues requires all jurisdictions with their own enforcement departments to enforce the latest edition of the State Electrical Code, as adopted by the State Electrical Board. Adoption of Ordinance 21-07 enables the Town to remain in compliance with CRS.

Financial Impact: Adoption of Ordinance 21-07 will have no direct financial impact to the budget.

<u>Alignment with Strategic Plan:</u> This ordinance aligns with Town Council's Quality Core Services.

<u>Environmental Sustainability:</u> Adoption of Ordinance 21-07 will have no direct effect on environmental sustainability.

<u>Staff Recommendation:</u> Staff recommends the Town Council adopt Ordinance 21-07 on second reading.
