RE: OPIOID SETTLEMENT INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
DATE: JANUARY 10, 2023

Summary and Background: The State of Colorado and all parties to this agreement each executed the Colorado Opioids Summary Memorandum of Understanding (the "Colorado MOU"), establishing the manner in which Opioid Settlement Funds shall be divided and distributed within the State of Colorado. All settlement funds, regardless of allocation, shall be used for Approved Purposes, as required in the Colorado MOU.

This agreement specifies that the funds collected from the entities be used for 1) Treatment, 2) Prevention, and 3) Additional areas like services for children, first responders, community leadership, staffing and training, research and administrative costs for approved purposes.

This Agreement also establishes an Opioid Funds Advisory Board that will meet at least annually to review and recommend the budget for these funds with the County budget.

Financial Impact: This amounts to less than \$2000.00 per year to be transferred to these programs at Summit County per year.

Staff Recommendation: Recommend that the Council allow the Mayor to execute the agreement on behalf of the Town of Frisco with his signature.
